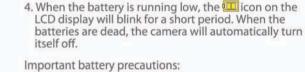

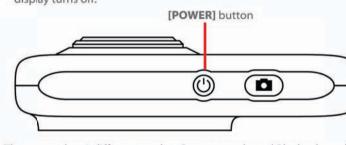

Turning the camera on/off

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

• Check the connection of the USB cable; make sure it is properly

· Try a different USB cable.

My photos are fuzzy or poor quality Make sure to keep the camera steady when taking photos (when

you hear a beep, this indicates the photo has been taken; hold the camera steady until then). Be aware of the lighting (the more light, the better your photos

will turn out). Clean the lens of your camera, and make sure it is free of finger

prints (clean only with a non-abrasive dry cloth and make sure the camera is turned off before cleaning).
