





Basic operation

Make sure the MP3 player is fully charged before turning it on.

- To turn on the player, make sure the [POWER] switch is in the "ON" position and press and HOLD the [►II] button until the display lights up.
- To turn off the player, press and HOLD the [►II]
- button until the display shuts off or slide the [POWER] switch to the "OFF" position.

Transferring media files to the player
