

Charging the EM514


1. Connect the small end of the included USB charging cable into the Mini USB charging port of the EM514

4. The RED [LED indicator Ring] shuts off when the

EM514 is fully charged (approximately 4 hours).

- 2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to your Computer's USB port.
- 3. The [LED indicator Ring] illuminates red while






- 3. Press and HOLD the [ON/OFF] button for 8 seconds until the [LED indicator Ring] light flashes RED
- 4. The EM514 is now in Pairing Mode and ready to connect to your mobile phone.




- NOTE: To enter the Pairing Mode, you must press and HOLD the [ON/OFF] button for approximately 8 seconds. This must be done while the headphones are powered off. Pairing mode will last 2 minutes. After two minutes the headset will return to standby mode.
- 5. Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices




6. When the phone finds the EM514, confirm by selecting EM514 from the list.





NOTE: Depending on which model mobile phone you are trying to connect the EM514 to, it may be necessary to enter a passcode and the following message (or similar) may appear on your phone's




Enter passcode "0000" if prompted by the phone.


NOTE: Make sure you charge your EM514 for a full 8 hours before using it for the first time.

8. Your mobile phone will confirm that the pairing was 2. Keep your EM514 and mobile phone within 3 feet of completed, and prompt you to accept the connection. Please respond YES to connect the EM514 to your mobile phone. If the pairing was successful, the EM514's [LED indicator Ring] flashes blue and BLUE alternately. slowly every 4 seconds.



mobile phone, you may see the message below, and your mobile phone will prompt you to accept the connection request to the EM514, and an option not to ask this again. Please accept the connection, and if you select "Don't ask this again", your phone will automatically accept future connection requests from vour EM514.



NOTE: The screenshots above are typical of many Bluetooth enabled phones in the market today and are used to assist in the explanation of the pairing process. Your mobile phone's interface and interaction with the EM514 may be slightly different from the illustrations above.

- 3. The PS3 will ask for a passkey. Enter [0000] then get back to the previous menu

NOTE: "Input Device" is the microphone, and determines the method of how others will hear PS3 audio and others speaking.

To test the connection, speak into the EM514 and you will see the bars above the "Microphone Level" moving, if not, repeat the pairing process.

Press "OK" to confirm the new settings. You are now ready to use the EM514 with your PS3 Entertainment System. If you would like to hear the PS3 audio through vour TV or Audio System, scroll to "Output Device" and switch to "System Default Device".

*The EM514 wireless headphones are compatible with any brand of Bluetooth-enabled phone or music device that supports Advanced Audio Distri-bution Profile (A2DP) and Audio Video Remote Control Profile (AVRCP).

In order for Bluetooth devices to communicate with one another properly, they must utilize the same Bluetooth profile. To determine the profiles supported by your device (mobile phone, gaming console, computer or mp3 player), please refer to the device's user guide.

Certain Bluetooth features including those listed may not be supported by all compatible Bluetoothenabled devices, and/or the functionality of such features may be limited in certain devices.

Playing music

the music player or application on your device, then quickpress the [PLAY / PAUSE] button. Once playback has begun, you can control the music or answer phone calls from the control buttons of the FM514 (not all mobile phones support the control of music using Bluetooth).

NOTE: Some phones or bluetooth enabled media players require that you first quickpress the [PLAY / PAUSE] button on your device before you can control the music with the EM514.

Play/Pause*

Press the [PLAY / PAUSE] button to pause the music. To resume music playback, press the [PLAY / PAUSE] button again.

Skipping songs*


Press the [PREVIOUS] button to go to the previous track. Press the [NEXT] button to go to the next track.
