


# EMDC100 Installing the Battery



## This camera has no internal memory and requires an SD card (not included) to take and save pictures or record videos. The camera can support SD cards up to **32GB**. To install the SD card into the camera, follow the steps below:

- 1. Turn the camera off. 2. Insert the SD card into the
- card slot (as shown below) until it clicks and locks into place. 3. To remove the card, gently push it in until it pops out.

· A card can only be inserted one way; do not use force when inserting the card. Inserting or removing a card while the camera is on may damage the card and files

# **Using the Voice Recorder**


- To access the camera's Voice Recorder, follow the instructions below: 1. Press the [MODE] button until the voice recorder is selected.

# To listen to your recording in Playback mode:

- 1. Press the [MODE] button until Playback mode is selected. 2. Use the [ UP] or [DOWN] keys to select your recording.
- 3. Press the [O] listen to your recording. 4. Press the [ O ] button again to stop playback.

### **Picture Playback Mode** 1. Make sure that an SD card is inserted into the camera.

- 2. Press the [ **U**] button to turn the camera **ON**. When the camera is powered ON, it will be in Video Mode and will automatically start recording.
- 3. Press the [O] button to stop recording. 4. Press the [MODE] button 3 times to switch to Playback Mode.
- The [ ] icon will appear in the upper right side of the LCD screen, meaning you are in Playback Mode. 5. Use the [ UP] and [ DOWN ] buttons to view your saved photos, voice

## recordings and videos. Video Playback Mode

- To access your video files stored on the camera's SD card, quick press
- the [MODE] button. The [ ] icon will appear in the upper right corner




