





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### **System Requirements**

Your MP3 Player needs the minimal system requirements for your computer.


What is USB?

- USB stands for Universal Serial Bus.
- It is a new interface based on the new concept between PC and peripherals.
- The maximum bandwidth is12 Mbps and a maximum of 127 USB devices can be connected to a single PC.

### How to use your MP3 Player

You'll need to have MP3 files stored on your computer, a data In/Out cable and your MP3 Player.

You can transfer songs from your PC to your MP3 Player via your USB port with a data In/Out Cable. Also, you can transfer data from your MP3 Player to your PC!

### To install Battery

### 1 Open the battery cover.



### 2 Insert the battery.

Make sure to match the + and - on the batteries to the marks inside the battery compartment.

### 3 Close the battery cover.

### **M** Notes


- Improper use of batteries may cause battery leakage and corrosion.
- If battery leakage occurs, wipe the battery liquid from the battery compartment, then insert new battery.

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### Connecting Data In/Out Cable

### To connect your MP3 Player to a PC

To complete setup, you should connect the supplied Data In/Out cable to a PC from your MP3 Player.



#### Compare the two ends of the cable.

Connect one end with the USB port on the back of your PC and then plug the other end into the Data In/Out terminal of your MP3 Player.



### **Before Operation**

#### Power on/off

- To turn on, press the POWER ON/OFF button for more than 1 second.
- To turn off, press the POWER ON/OFF button for more than 1.5 seconds on the pause (or stop) mode.



### To use Earphone

Connect the earphone connector to the earphone jack.



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### **Basic Operation**

#### To skip the files

#### To skip the next file

Press  $\mathsf{SKIP}/\mathsf{SEARCH}$  (  $\blacktriangleright\!\!\blacktriangleright\!\!\!\mid$  ) button on the main unit to select the next file.

#### To skip the previous file

Press SKIP/SEARCH (◄◄) button on the main unit twice.

### To return the beginning of the current file

Press SKIP/SEARCH (◄◄) button on the main unit once.

#### To play rewind search or fast forward search the files

Press **SKIP**/**SEARCH** ( | ◀◀ / ▶▶ ) button for more than 2 seconds during file playing.

#### To select the Function mode

Press the FUNCTION (F) button repeatedly more than 1 second.

- You can choose the music, voice or FM radio mode.by pressing SKIP/SEARCH(I◄◄/▶►) button and then press (▶) button to confirm.
- The function mode is not chosen during recording mode.

#### **Speed Function**

### Press the SPEED button repeatedly and briefly.

- You can choose the playing speed of a file (-30%, -15% or +15% of normal playing speed).

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### **Before Operation**


### **Hold Function**

- This function locks the main unit to prevent it from operating when you accidentally press a button.
- Unlock it before operating.
- In POWER ON state, if you set the Hold Switch (◀HOLD) on the main unit to lock position, "★●" appears in the LCD.
- In POWER OFF state, if you press a button in lock position, the "HOLD ON !!!" blinks about 2 seconds in the LCD.



#### To adjust Volume

- You can adjust the volume by pressing volume (+/-) buttons.
- The volume level can be adjusted by 35 steps.

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### **Advanced Operation**

### **Book Mark Function**

If you set Book Mark function during file playing, you can search the setting point of the track automatically.

- ¶ Select the setting point you want during file playing, press and hold the Book Mark (B.MARK) button for about 2 seconds.
  "□" appears in the LCD.
- 2 Press Book Mark (B.MARK) button briefly once during other file playing.

Automatically, the player searches and plays from the setting point.

To cancel Book Mark function, press the Book Mark (B.MARK) button for about 2 seconds.

"III" disappears in the LCD.

#### **Local Repeat Function**

You can set local repeat by pressing Book Mark (B.MARK) button. If you select local repeat ending point within 3 seconds, after setting the local repeat starting point, it is not operated.

- To select the local repeat starting point you want during file playing, press Book Mark (B.MARK) button briefly once.
- " A ▶ " appears in the LCD.
- 2 To select the local repeat ending point you want during file playing, press the button again.
- " A ► B " appears in the LCD.
- To cancel local repeat function, press the Book Mark (B.MARK) button.
- "A ► B" disappears in the LCD.

#### **™** Note

The Book Mark and Local Repeat Function is not available to the FM radio mode.

### **Basic Operation**

- PLAY (►) button
- PAUSE/STOP (II/■) button • POWER ON/OFF button

#### To play files

SKIP/SEARCH (I◀◀ / ▶▶I) button

### 1 Press POWER ON/OFF button to turn on.

- 2 Press SKIP/SEARCH (◄◄ / ▶►) button to select a file you went
- 3 Press PLAY (►) button button to play a file.

#### To pause files

Press PAUSE/STOP (II/■) button during file playing.

#### To stop files

Press PAUSE/STOP (II/ $\blacksquare$ ) button for more than 2 seconds on the main unit during file playing.

#### M Note

- In case of playing a WMA file with 32kbps (or less), it is available to play it.
- Playing a MP3 file with a low bit rate (64kbps or less) may cause to delay a button operation discontinued.

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### **Advanced Operation**

### **EQUALIZER** Function

You can choose between 5 filxed sound mode.

Press MENU button 2 seconds, press Function button and then select "EQUALIZER" menu.



2 Press SKIP/SEARCH(◄◄/►►) button and then select the EQ mode.



3 Select the function you want to operate by pressing PLAY (►) button and then press MENU button again. to exit " EQ "mode.

#### **M** Notes

• This Function is not available to the FM radio mode.

### **Language Function**

You can choose between 4 language mode.

**1** Press MENU button 2 seconds, press Function button and then select "Language" menu.



**2** Press SKIP/SEARCH(I◀◀ / ▶►I) button and then select PLAY (►) button.





3 Press MENU button to exit "Language" menu.

- "CH-SP" Simple Chinese display
- "CH-TD" Traditional Chinese display
- "ENG" English display
- "JPN" Japanese display

#### **M** Notes

• This Function is invalid to the FM radio mode.

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### **Advanced Operation**

### **Voice Activity Detect VAD**

Before you record on MP3 Player, you can set the VAD function.

Press MENU button 2 seconds, press Function button and then select "MIC VAD" menu.



2 Press SKIP/SEARCH (I◄◄ / ►►) button and then select PLAY (►) button to select ON or OFF.





3 Press MENU button to exit "MIC VAD" menu.

### Advanced Operation

### **ID3 Language Function**

You can choose between 5 language mode.

1 Press MENU button 2 seconds, press Function button and then select "ID3 Language" menu.



2 Press SKIP/SEARCH(I◄◄/►►) button and then select PLAY (►) button.





3 Press MENU button to exit "Language" menu.

- "CH-SP" Simple Chinese display
- "CH-TD" Traditional Chinese display
- "KOR" Korean diaplay
- "ENG" English display
- "JPN" Japanese display

#### **M** Notes

- This Function is invalid to the FM radio mode.
- If the song has no ID3 function, it will display the file name only.

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### **Advanced Operation**

### **REPEAT Function**

Press (REC) button to choose between 5 fixed repeat mode.

NORMAL	A	Plays one time in oder.	
INTRO	INT - →	Plays the first 10 seconds only for each track of the files.	
RANDOM	RD A	Plays randomly.	
REPEAT ALL	()A	Plays repeatedly all file.	
REPEAT ONE	19	Plays repeatedly the current selected file.	

#### M Noto

- The REPEAT Function is not available to the FM radio mode.
- After all file is played one time in oder in the INTRO mode, the unit is stopped automatically
- The selection of the above repeat mode only effects at play mode.


### Advanced Operation

#### **BACK LIGHT Function**

Press MENU button 2 seconds, select "BACK LIGHT" menu. This function can change the color of the LCD.

1 Set the color (RED,BLUE,CYAN,GREEN,VIOLET,WHITE,YELLOW) of the LCD by using SKIP/SEARCH (◄◄ /▶➡) button.





- 2 Press PLAY(►) button to set and then press MENU button to exit the backlight function.
- 3 Set backlight time by long pressing "VOL +" button for 2 seconds. Press "VOL +" button for 2 seconds to turn off the back light.

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### **Advanced Operation**

#### **Voice Bit Rate**


Before you record on MP3 Player, you can setect the Voice bit rate level.

1 Press MENU button 2 seconds, press Function button and then select "VOICE B/R" menu.



**2** Press SKIP/SEARCH (I◀◀ / ▶▶) button and then select PLAY (▶) button.






3 Press MENU button to exit "VOICE B/R" menu.

### **Advanced Operation**

#### **Line In Bit Rate**

When you record on MP3 Player, select on line in bit rate level.

Press MENU button 2 seconds, press Function button and then select "LINE IN B/R" menu.



**2** Press SKIP/SEARCH (◄◀ / ▶➡) button and then select PLAY (▶) button.



3 Press MENU button to exit "LINE IN B/R" menu.

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### **Advanced Operation**

#### **Select the voice record Bit Rate**

1 When you record voice on MP3 Player, select on voice bit rate level.



### To check memory and version information

 Press MENU button for 2 seconds, and press Function button to show the information :

### **Advanced Operation**

### To delete files on MP3 Player

Press MENU button 2 seconds, press Function button and then select "ERASE" menu.




2 Press SKIP/SEARCH (I◄◄ / ►►) button and to select YES then press PLAY (►) button.



3 Press button (+/-) button to select files.



Press ( > ) button, to delete the files, press ( F ) button, back to the menu, Press (MENU) button to exit "ERASE" menu.





#### **M** Notes

- This Function only can work at stop or pause mode.
- Files can't erase at FM Radio or MP3 Files when working.


### To format files on MP3 Player

Press MENU button 2 seconds, press Function button and then select "FORMAT" menu.



2 Display will show normal or quick format function, Press SKIP/ SEARCH (I◄◄ /►) button to choose normal or quick format, Press (►) button to start format, Press (F) to exit menu.

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### **Advanced Operation**

#### **FM BAND**

1 Press MENU button 2 seconds, press Function button and then select "FM BAND" menu.



2 Press SKIP/SEARCH (I◄◄ / ▶►) button and then select PLAY (►) button.




3 To exit "FM BAND"mode, press FUNCTION (F)button 2 seconds, then press SKIP/SEARCH( I◀◀ / ▶▶I ) to setect other play mode.

### **Advanced Operation**

### **VOICE RECORDING**

- ¶ Press the Function (F) button for more than 1 second , then select"
  RECORD" menu,and press( ► )button.
- **2** Set the "voice bitrate" (Reference p.28). Recording setting is completed.
- 3 Press Record (.. REC) button briefly one time on pause/stop mode.



4 Start the voice recording to the Microphone (MIC) on the main unit.

5 To stop the voice recording, press (REC) button. The voice recording is completed.

### **M** Notes

- The recorded files are stored VORC001.MP3, VORC002.MP3, VORC003.MP3.... in order.
- If the "FULL!!!" appears in the LCD, delete some files to save voice recording available time.
- Enter the "Voice" folder to play the recorded file.

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### **Advanced Operation**

### Auxiliary Input Recording

- 1 Set the bitrate for line in record. (Reference P25)
- 2 Enter record mode by pressing Function (F) button for more than 1 second.
- Auxiliary Input recording setting is completed.
- 3 Connect the auxiliary Input/Output cable to the auxiliary input jack and the auxiliary output jack on the auxiliary main unit.



- 4 Press Record (••REC) button briefly on stop mode and start playing the auxiliary main unit. The auxiliary Input recording is started.
- **5** To pause the recording, press( ▶) button. to stop the voice recording, press (... REC) button, the line in recording is completed.

#### Motes

- The recorded files are stored LINI001.MP3, LINI002.MP3, LINI003.MP3... in order.
- If the "FULL!!!" appears in the LCD, delete some files to save voice recording available time.
- Enter "LINE IN" folder to play the recorded file.

### Radio Operation

3 Repeat steps 1 to 3 to store other frequency.

#### To recall preset numbers

Press MENU button and press SKIP/SEARCH (◄◄ /►►)


#### Erasing a preset radio frequency

When you want to delete the stored radio frequency, press Book Mark (B.MARK) button for more than 1 second on the PRESET MODE of FM radio.

### Radio Operation

### Listening to the radio

- 1 Press the Function (F) button for more than 1 second, press (I◀◀ / ▶▶I) button to choose FM RADIO and press (▶) button . The FM radio is selected.
- 2 Press the Function (F) button to choose the mode. (ST: Stereo, MO: Mono)



3 Select the radio frequency by pressing SKIP/SEARCH

(I◀◀ / ▶▶I) button

- Manual Tuning
- Press SKIP/ SEARCH (I◀◀ / ▶▶ ) button briefly and repeatedly.
- Automatic Tuning
   Press SKIP/ SEARCH (I◄◄ / ▶►I ) button for more than 1 second. (Scanning stops when the unit tunes in a station.)

### **M** Notes

- If you listen to FM radio, insert the earphone into earphone jack. The earphone plays the part of the antenna.
- If you press the PLAY (▶) button during FM radio receiving, the sound is muted.



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### Presetting the radio frequency

You can preset 20 stations on the radio.

1 Select the radio frequency you want to preset by pressing SKIP/SEARCH (◄◄/►►) button on the SEARCH MODE of FM radio. (EX: When you preset the FM 87.5 MHz).

All available radio stations with sufficient signal strength will be

- Press (B.MARK) button for 2 seconds will be auto scan.

**2** Press B.MARK button and SKIP/SEARCH(◄◄ / ▶► )button to select the store number, then press B.MARK button again,a preset number is stored.




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### Radio Operation

#### Radio recording

1 Select FM RADIO function.

2 Select a station you want to record.



- 3 During FM receiving, press the Record (•• REC) button. Start radio recording.
- **4** To pause the recording, press( ▶) button. to stop the voice recording, press (... REC) button. the radio recording is completed.

- The recorded files are stored FMRC001,MP3, FMRC002,MP3, FMRC003.MP3.... in order.
- If the "FULL!!!" appears in the LCD, delete the files to save voice recording available hour.

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• Enter"Radio"folder to play the recorded file.

### Troubleshooting

- 1. The MP3 Player does not work or nothing is displayed on the LCD.
- Check the polarity (+ and -) of the battery.
- 2. The buttons are not working.
- Check if the Hold Switch is on.
- There is no battery or the battery is fully consumed.
- 3. The files can not be downloaded.
- Check the connection between the USB port of your PC and the USB cable.
- Format the MP3 Player.
