



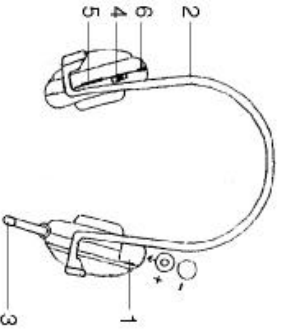
AM / FM HEADPHONE RADIO

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Before operating this product, read, understand, and follow these instructions. Be sure to save these instructions for future reference.

- Do not use the radio for any purpose other than its intended use.
- This product is not intended for use by children.
- Never operate this product if it is not working properly, has been dropped, damaged, or exposed to water or other liquids. This unit has no user-serviceable parts. Only qualified service personnel should perform any servicing. Do not attempt to examine or repair this product yourself. Return the product to a service center for examination and repair.
- Do not place or store product near water or other liquids. Do not store or expose this radio to direct sunlight or very hot or cold temperatures.
- Do not expose batteries to fire or other heat sources. Follow the battery manufacturer's safety and usage instructions.



1. Battery Door
2. Neck Band
3. FM Antenna*
4. AM/FM Band Switch
5. Tuning Knob
6. Power Switch / Volume Control Knob

*The radio has a built-in AM antenna.

NOTE: Remove the batteries from the radio if they are exhausted or when storing the radio for an extended period of time. When replacing the batteries, use new batteries of the same size. Do not mix a used battery with a new battery, or mix different chemistries or sizes of batteries. Never throw batteries into a fire. Do not expose batteries to fire or other heat sources. Follow the battery manufacturer's safety and usage instructions.

1. Remove the Battery Door from the headphones and insert two (2) "AAA" size alkaline batteries (not included). Be sure to align the battery polarity (+/-) as indicated on top of the Battery Door.
2. Replace the Battery Door onto the headphones and ensure it is securely in place.
3. **NOTE:** Remove the batteries when the radio is not in use to prevent damage to the radio due to rusted or corroded batteries.

Radio Operation:

1. Rotate the Power Switch / Volume Control Knob clockwise until power is applied to the radio and the desired volume level is reached.
2. Select either AM or FM on the AM/FM Band Switch as desired.
3. To tune the radio, rotate the Tuning Knob until the desired frequency is reached.
4. To turn the radio off, rotate the Power Switch / Volume Control Knob counterclockwise until the switch is in the "OFF" position.

FCC Requirements
