Installing recording paper (A4 size)

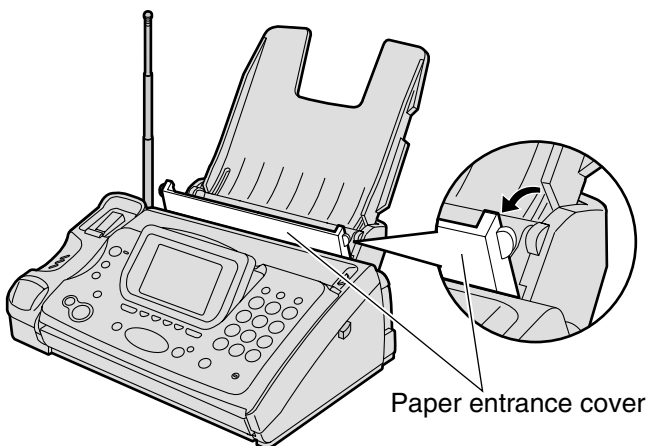
1 Install the recording paper tray.

- 3 Insert the right tab into the right slot of the main unit.



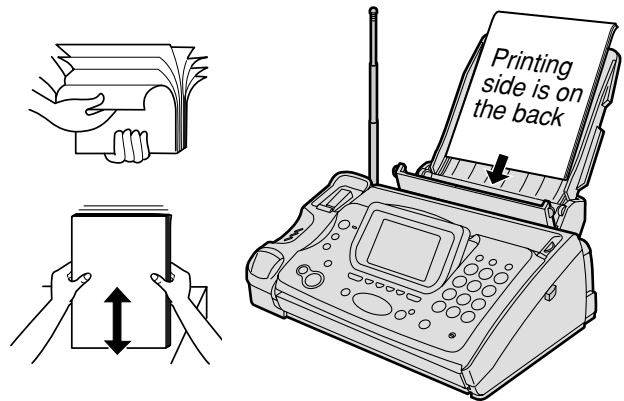
2 Insert the recording paper into the recording paper tray.

- 1 Open the paper entrance cover until it locks.

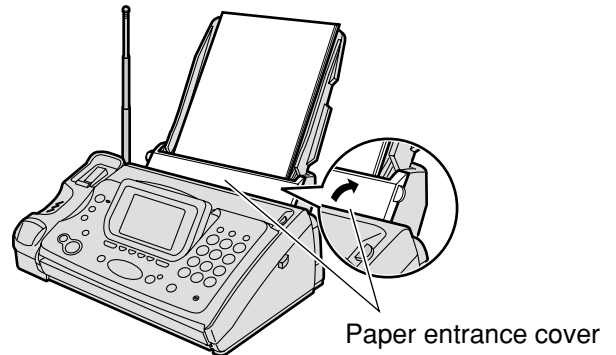

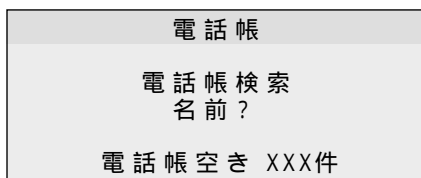
- A space is counted as one character in the number of the maximum input characters.
- When entering e-mail address, the small letters are displayed before the capital letters.
- When entering e-mail address, you can not enter the following symbols: \ . - . 「 」
- When entering e-mail message, pressing **#** enables you to begin the new line. (“↵” is displayed.)
- The display items of the main unit are somewhat different from those of the portable handset.

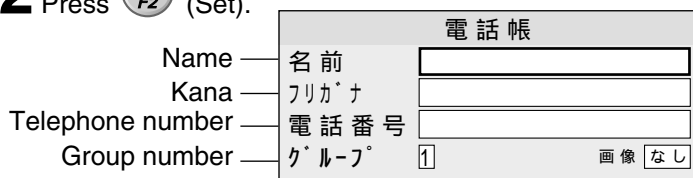
Storing names and telephone numbers in the phonebook



- Press (Phonebook) and (Register).
 - "XXX" shows the number of remaining stations you can store.
 - You can program up to 150 stations, including 4 pre-programmed stations.

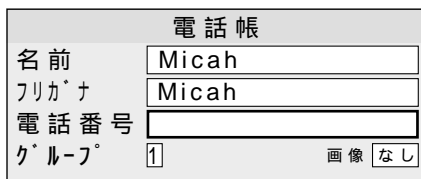


- Press (Set).



- Enter the name, up to 20 characters (see the table on page 9 for instructions), then press (Register).

- Press (Down) twice and (Set).



- Enter the telephone number, up to 24 digits.
 - To correct a mistake, press (Clear).

- Press (Register).

- If necessary, press (Down) and (Set), then enter the group number (1–9).

- Press (Register).

- To program other items, press (Next station) and repeat steps 2 to 9.

- Press (Stop) to exit the program.

Making a voice call using the phonebook

- Press (Phonebook).
- Press (Search button) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.
- Lift the handset or press (Speakerphone).

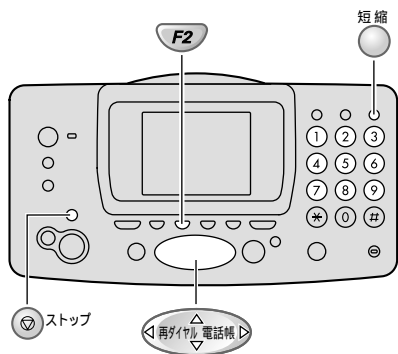
Editing a stored name or number

- Press (Phonebook).
- Press (Search button) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.
- Press (Edit).
- Press (Set) and edit the name (see the table on page 9 for instructions), then press (Register).
 - If you do not need to edit the name, skip to step 5.
- Press (Search button) to select the kana column.
 - If you do not need to edit the kana, skip to step 7.
- Press (Set) and enter the correct kana, then press (Register).
- Press (Search button) to select the telephone number column.
 - If you do not need to edit the telephone number, skip to step 9.
- Press (Set) and enter the correct telephone number, then press (Register).
- If necessary, press (Search button) to select the group number column.
 - If you do not need to edit the group number, skip to step 11.
- Press (Set), and enter the group number (1-9), then press (Register).
- Press (Stop) to exit the program.

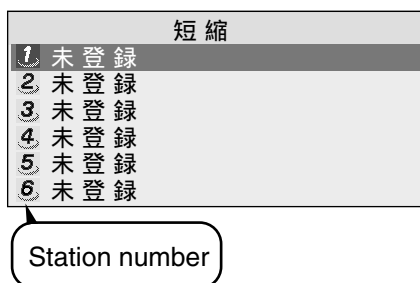
Storing names and telephone numbers in the speed dialer

You can store up to 9 names and telephone numbers which are stored in the phonebook. The dialing buttons (1 to 9) function as memory stations.



1 Press (Speed dialer).

2 Press the memory station number (1 to 9).



3 Press (Register).

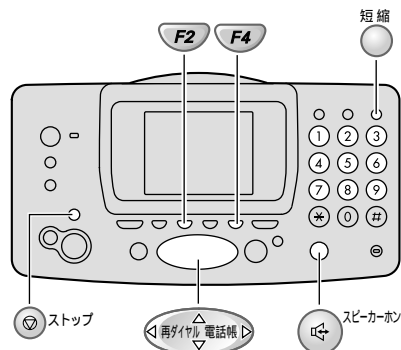
4 Press (Search button) repeatedly until the desired name is displayed.

5 Press (Register).

- To program other items in other stations, repeat steps 2 to 5.

6 Press (Stop) to exit the program.

Making a voice call using the speed dialer



1 Press (Speed dialer).

2 Press the memory station number (1 to 9).

3 Lift the handset or press (Speakerphone).

Erasing a name and number stored in the speed dialer

1 Press (Speed dialer).

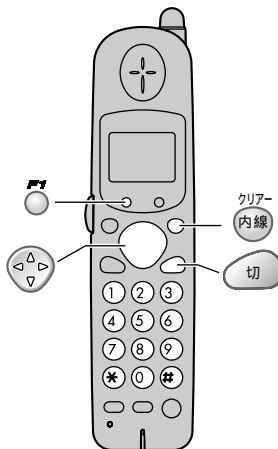

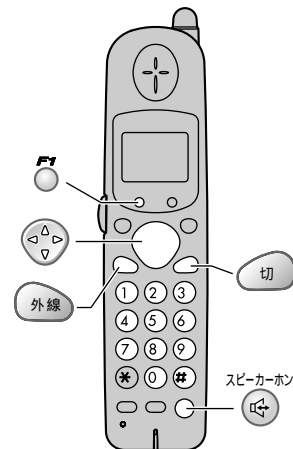

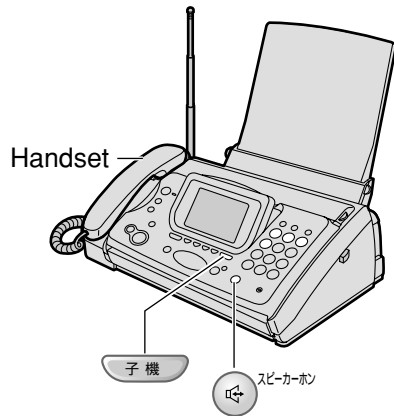

Intercom between the main unit and portable handset

An intercom is available between the main unit and portable handset.

Using the main unit:



1 ■ For single portable handset users

- ① Lift the handset.

- ② Press **子機** (Portable handset).

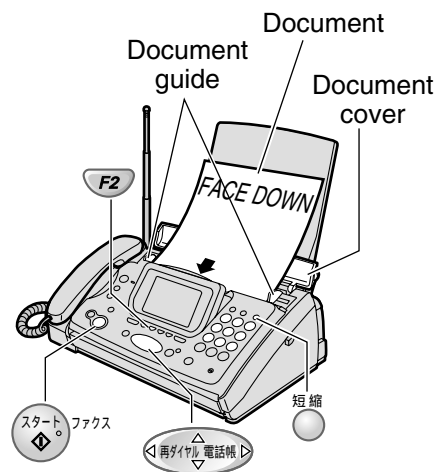
Sending faxes

Sending a fax manually



- 1 Open the document cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- 3 If necessary, press (Resolution) repeatedly to select the desired setting (see below).
- 4 Dial the fax number.
- 5 Press (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

Sending a fax using the phonebook/speed dialer



- 1 Open the document cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- 3 If necessary, press (Resolution) repeatedly to select the desired setting (see below).
- 4 ■ When using the phonebook
Press (Phonebook), then press (Search button) until the desired name is displayed.
■ When using the speed dialer
Press (Speed dialer), then press memory station number (to).
- 5 Press (Fax).
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

To select the resolution

Select the desired resolution according to the type of document, by pressing (Resolution).

Receiving faxes

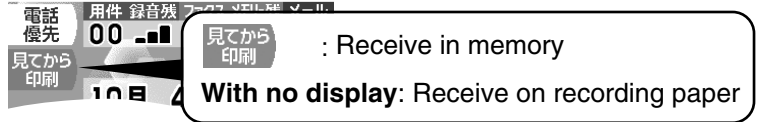
You can select beforehand whether to receive faxes by “Receive in memory” or “Receive on recording paper”.

Receive in memory: (Default setting) The received fax will be stored in memory. You can check the contents on the display, then print them if necessary.

Receive on recording paper: The received fax will be printed on recording paper.

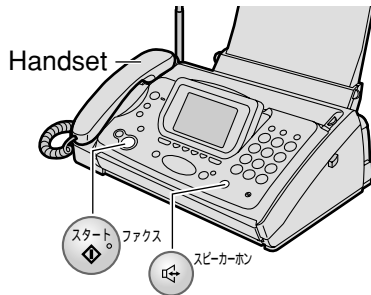
■ Setting/canceling “Receive in memory”

Press **F4** (ファクス切替). (Changes each time it is pressed.)



Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)

Using the main unit:



1 When you hear a ring, lift the handset or press

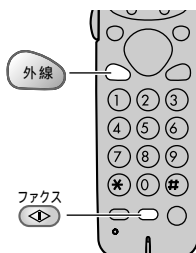

2 When: –document reception is required, –a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or –no sound is heard,

• The unit will start fax reception.

Using the portable handset:



1 When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger to answer the call.

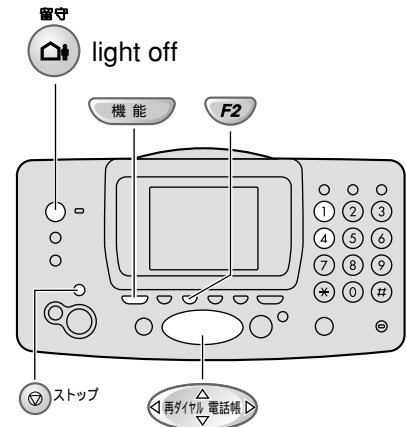
• If the portable handset is not set on the charger, press **外線** (Talk).

2 When: –document reception is required, –a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or –no sound is heard,

press **ファクス** (Fax reception) until a single beep is heard.

• The main unit will start fax reception.

Setting ANSWER mode



If the **留守** (Auto answer) light is on, turn it off by

pressing **留守**.

When AUTO ANSWER mode is off, the unit provides two types of receiving modes: “電話優先” (Telephone) mode and “ファクス優先” (Fax/Telephone) mode.

Telephone mode (電話優先) –Pre-selected setting: Select this mode when you plan to answer the calls yourself. When receiving calls, you have to answer all calls manually.

Fax/Telephone mode (ファクス優先): Select this mode when you are near the unit and want to use it to receive voice calls yourself and fax calls automatically.

Change the setting if you want to use this mode.

1. Press **機能** (Function) and **4 1**.

2. Press **再ダイヤル電話機** (Search button) repeatedly to select the desired mode.

■ To print new fax only

Press (Change button function) twice, then press (Print new fax).

■ To print only a required page

- Press (Change button function) twice, then press (Print a page).
- Enter the start page and press (Set).
- Enter the end page and press (Set).

■ To print all faxes

Press (Change button function), then press (Print all).

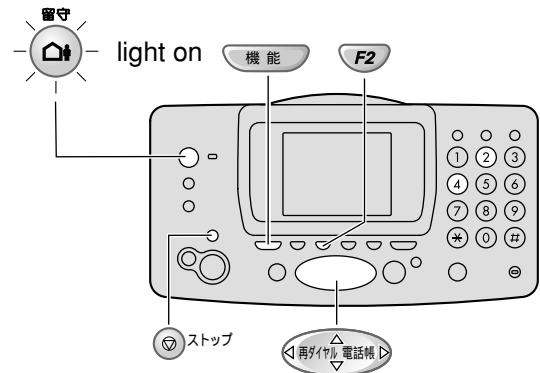
Recording your own greeting message




You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.

- 1** Press  (Record), then press .
- 2** Lift the handset.
- 3** Press  (Set) and record your greeting message, up to 16 seconds, using the handset.
- 4** Press  (Stop), then replace the handset.
 - Your greeting message will be played back automatically.

Setting AUTO ANSWER mode



AUTO ANSWER mode will work when the  (Auto answer) light is on.

AUTO ANSWER mode provides three types of receiving modes: “ファクス / 留守電” (Fax/Answering device) mode, “ファクス専用” (Fax only) mode and “留守電専用” (Answering device only) mode.

Fax/Answering device mode (ファクス / 留守電)

–Pre-selected setting:

Select this mode when you want to receive all voice and fax calls automatically.





Fax only mode (ファクス専用):

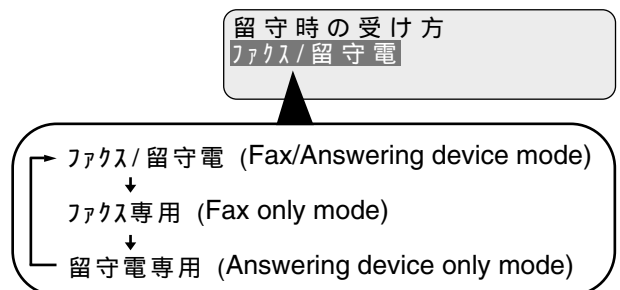
Select this mode when you wish to use the unit only as a fax machine.



Answering device only mode (留守電専用):

Select this mode when you wish to use the unit only as a telephone answering device.

Change the setting if you want to use the fax only mode or answering device only mode.

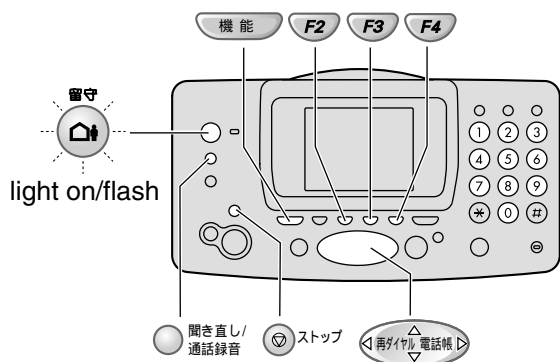
- 1.** Press  (Function), then press  .
- 2.** Press  (Search button) repeatedly to select the desired receiving mode.



- 3.** Press  (Register), then press  (Stop).

Operating the built-in answering device

Activating the answering device



- 1 Turn the (Auto answer) light on by pressing .
- 2 When receiving a call, a greeting message will be played and the unit will record a voice message.
 - To record your own greeting message, see page 19.

Listening to recorded messages

When new messages are recorded, the (Auto answer) light will flash.

Press to listen to recorded messages.

After the messages are played back, the following will be displayed.

Erasing a specific message

Press (Erase) while listening to the message you want to erase, then press (Yes).

Erasing all of the recorded messages

- 1 Press (Record), then press (Set).
- 2 Press (Yes).

Erasing your own greeting message

- 1 Press (Record), then press .
- 2 Press (Yes).
 - The pre-recorded Japanese greeting message will be played when you receive a call.

Operating the answering device from a remote location

Preparation: Programming the remote operation ID

1. Press (Function), then press .
2. Enter any 4-digit number (remote operation ID) except * or #.
3. Press (Register).
4. Press (Stop).

Operation: Listening to a recorded message from a remote location

Turn the (Auto answer) light on before you go out. Remote operations are available only from a touch tone telephone.

1. Call your unit.
2. Enter the remote operation ID during the greeting message.
3. Press or wait 4 seconds.
 - Only the new recorded messages will be played back.
 - To listen to all the recorded messages, press after the new messages have been played back.

L-mode service

“L-mode” is a convenient service of NTT offering with web browsing and e-mail.

To use L-mode service, please contract with NTT.

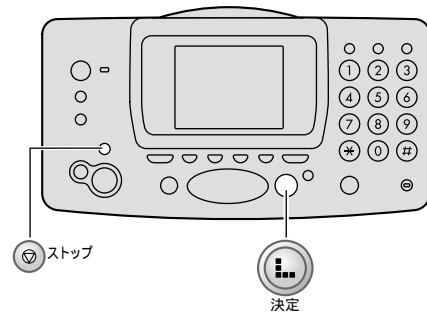

Setting up L-mode service

You should set up your unit before using L-mode service.

Important:

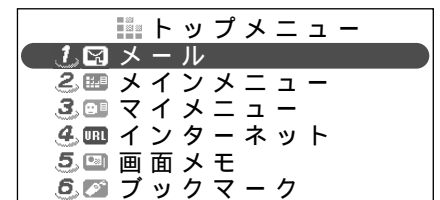
- You should set up your unit after subscription of “L-mode” service is completed.
You cannot set up your unit until the service becomes available.
- When your unit is turned off, the required data for L-mode is deleted and L-mode service will not be available.
The following setting is necessary to use L-mode service again after switching on the power supply.



- 1** Press  (L-mode) twice.
 - The required data for L-mode will be downloaded.
- 2** Press  (L-mode) when the following is displayed.



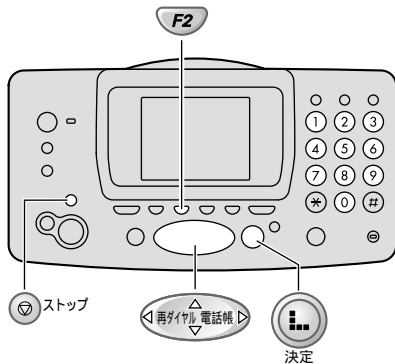
- The top menu is displayed and you can use L-mode service continuously. (The transmission charge will be added.)



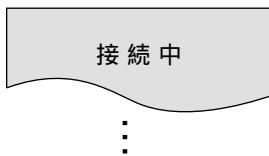
