PRECAUTIONS IN THE USE

SAFETY

- * This amplifier is only use power of 110V/60Hz or 220V/50Hz switch
- * If some foreign objects into the set, unplug the power cord and have it to a qualified service personnel for checking.
- * If this set will not be use for a long time, unplug the power cord from outlet. Hold the plug when unplugging the cord.

PLACEMENT

- * To avoid overheat, keep space around this amplifier.
- * To avoid the blocking of ventilation holes, do not place this unit on a carpet or close to a curtain.
- * Do not place the amplifier in direct sunlight or near a heat emitting object, and keep the set free from dust and vibration.
- * Place the unit in a horizontal position.
- * Do not place anything heavy on the set.

OPERATION

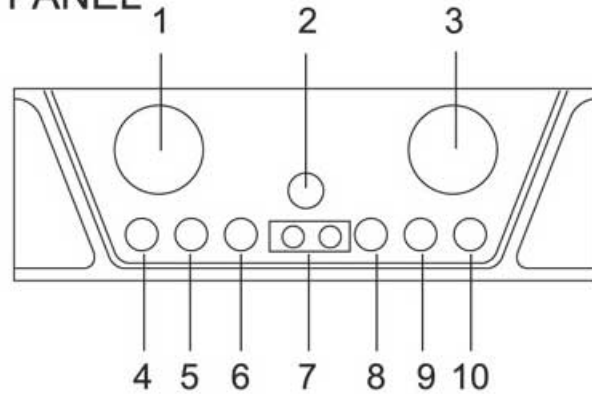
Unplug the power cord if the amplifier not used for a long time. So that can save the outlay of electric energy and extend the life of amplifier.

CLEANING

Use the soft cloth with a bit of neutral detergent to clean the cover, panel and controls. To avoid defacement, never use solvent such as alcohol or gas.

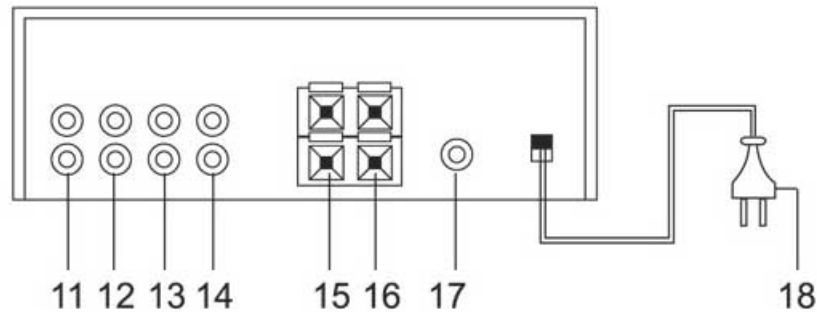
CONTROLS AND COMPONENTS

| 5. Mic 1 volume control | 10. Bass control |

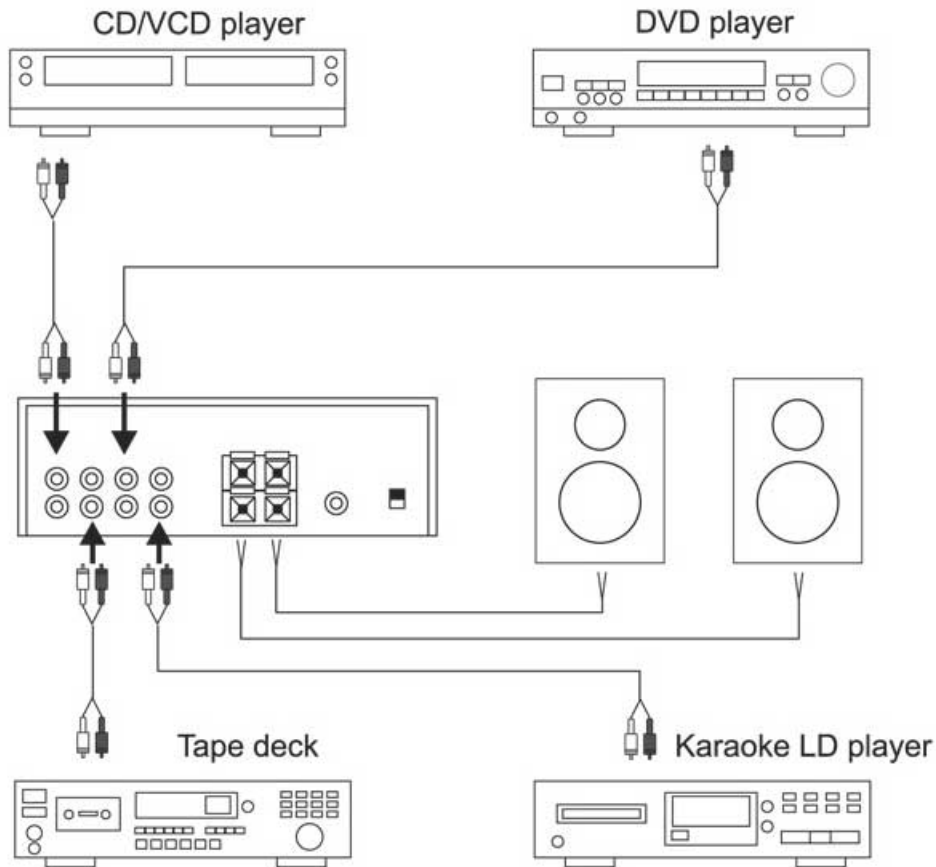
REAR PANEL

CONNECTION

Do not plug the power cord until all connection have been completed.



KARAOKE OPERATION

When playback karaoke program

1. Set the source selector (3) to karaoke position.
2. Connect LD player output socket to karaoke input socket.
3. Insert the plug of microphone into microphone socket (7), set the switch of microphone to ON position.
4. Adjust the microphone volume (5&6), set the Karaoke echo control to a proper position, it is ready for karaoke.

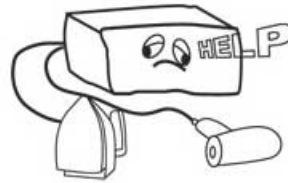
Note: Keep microphone long distance from the speaker to avoid generation of shrill sound.
