



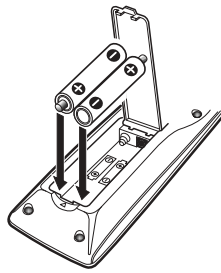

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Installing The Batteries

- Step 1.** Release the battery cover by pressing the tab and tilting the cover upward.
- Step 2.** Install two "AAA" batteries as shown. Be sure to match the +/- signs on the batteries with the +/- marks inside the case.



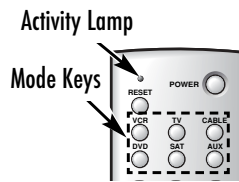
Note: **Do Not** mix new and used batteries or mix different types of batteries together.

PROGRAMMING THE REMOTE CONTROL

- Step 1.** Find your equipments' codes in the charts in this instruction guide.
- Step 2.** Press and hold the **VCR**, **TV**, **Cable Box**, **DVD Player**, or **Satellite Receiver** mode key while entering a three-digit code number. Then release the key.

If the code was accepted, the **Activity Lamp** will flash 5 times after the Mode key is released. If you entered an invalid code, the **Activity Lamp** will *not* flash. Check the code number and repeat Step 2.



The **VCR**, **TV**, **Cable Box**, **DVD**, and **Satellite** modes will accept only each mode's specific code type.

The **AUX** mode will accept all code types, but only one at a time.

Perform Steps 1 and 2 for each piece of equipment you have. After entering each code number check the unit's operation by pressing the **Power** and/or **Channel** keys. If these keys operate your equipment, you have probably entered the correct code number for that device. If not, follow Steps 1 and 2 and enter another code, if available.

After programming the remote control and confirming its operation, enter your codes in the spaces below for easy reference.

OPERATING THE REMOTE CONTROL

This remote control has six operating modes. To select a mode, press and release the mode key that matches the unit you want to control, **TV**, **VCR**, **Cable Box**, **DVD Player**, or **Satellite Receiver**. (The **AUX** mode can be programmed to operate any of these devices.)

OPERATING TIPS AND TROUBLESHOOTING HINTS

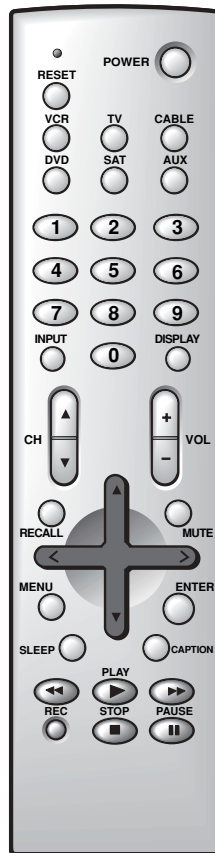
- To operate each device, you must first program the remote control, then press the proper mode key. The **VCR**, **TV**, and **DVD** modes are preprogrammed with Sanyo codes.
- Some manufacturers use many different codes. If your brand of equipment has more than one code listed, try programming your remote with the different available codes until you locate the correct one for your device.
- There may be brands and models that this remote control cannot operate. Some units may operate only partially.
- The **Reset** and **Caption** keys only operate Sanyo TVs.
- Codes will remain in memory for five minutes as you replace batteries.
- Remove batteries from the remote control if it will not be used for a month or more. Weak batteries may leak and damage the remote control.
- This remote control uses an invisible (infrared) beam of light to operate the equipment. Objects between the equipment and the remote control can block the beam of light. Therefore, the remote control must be pointed directly at the equipment you want to operate.
- This remote control cannot add keys or features to your equipment.
- When switching from the **VCR** or **DVD** mode to the **TV** mode, the **VCR/DVD** specific control keys will continue to operate the last device (mode) selected. For example, when switching from **DVD** to **TV** mode, the **VCR/DVD** control keys will continue to function as **DVD** keys.
- Replace the batteries if the remote control fails to operate any of your equipment. Be sure to install batteries correctly.
- Many of the remote control keys are multi-functional. Refer to the chart on the inside of the carton for a brief description of the keys and their functions. Refer to your original operating manuals for specific feature operation.
- The keys on this remote operate functions similar to those of your original remote controls. Refer to your original instructions for specific key and features operation.

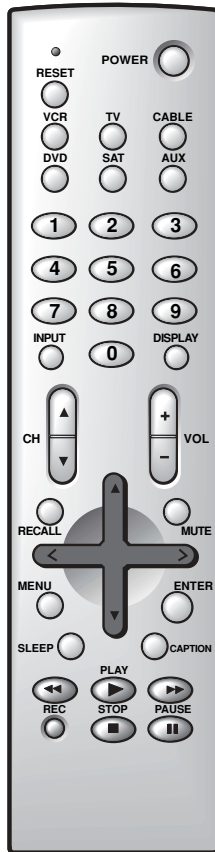

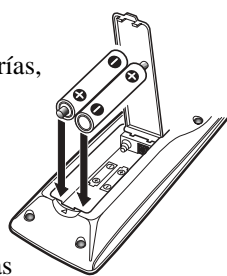

ANTES DE INICIAR SU USO

Instalación de las baterías

Paso 1 – Quite la cubierta de las baterías, presionando la pestaña, e inclinando la cubierta hacia adelante.



Paso 2 – Instale dos baterías tipo "AAA" como se muestra. Asegurándose que las marcas de + / - concuerden con los signos de las baterías, y con las marcas de +/- dentro de la caja del control remoto.

Nota: No mezcle baterías nuevas y usadas, o mezcle diferentes tipos de baterías al mismo tiempo.

PROGRAMANDO EL CONTROL REMOTO

Paso 1 – Localice los códigos de la marca de sus equipos en las cartas.

Paso 2 – Presione y mantenga la tecla de VCR, TV, Cable Box, DVD Player, o Satellite Receiver mientras accesa el código de tres dígitos.

Si el código fue aceptado, la luz de Actividad encenderá cinco (5) veces después que la tecla de Mode es liberada. Si se introdujo un código inválido, la luz de Actividad no encenderá. Verifique el número de código y repita el paso 2.



El modo *VCR*, *TV*, *Cable*, *DVD*, y *Satellite* aceptará únicamente códigos de tipo.

El modo *AUX* aceptará todo tipo de códigos, pero solo un código a la vez.

Ejecute los pasos 1 y 2 para cada tipo de equipo que se tenga. Después de agregar cada código, verifique la operación presionando las teclas de Encendido ó de Canales. OPERACIÓN DEL CONTROL REMOTO

Este control remoto tiene seis modos de operación. Para seleccionar un modo, presione y libere la tecla de modo (mode) que indique el aparato que se quiera controlar, TV, VCR, Decodificador de Cable, Reproductor de DVD o Receptor Via Satellite.

TIPS DE OPERACIÓN Y ANALISIS DE FALLAS

- Para operar cada equipo, Ud. debe programar primero el control remoto; y posteriormente presionar la tecla adecuada al modo seleccionado.
- Algunos fabricantes usan muchos códigos diferentes. Si la marca de su equipo tiene mas de un código listado, trate de programar su control remoto con los diferentes códigos disponibles hasta que localice el código correcto para su aparato.
- Pueden existir marcas y modelos donde este control remoto no funciona. Algunas unidades pueden operar solo parcialmente.
- Las teclas de Caption y Reset solo operan en TV's Sanyo.
- Los números de los códigos se mantendrán en memoria por cinco minutos cuando Ud. reemplace las baterías.
- Retirez les piles si vous comptez ne pas utiliser la télécommande pendant un mois ou plus. Des piles faibles peuvent fuir et causer des dommages.
