






04. When cleaning the LCD screen, unplug the unit and wipe it gently with a soft cloth.



Main Features and Basic Operations

Front Side

- 1.TXT: Press to enter the E-book directory
- 2.MOVIE: Press to enter the movie directory.
- 3.MUSIC: Press to enter the music directory.
- 4.PHOTO: Press to enter the photo directory.
- 5. Directional Keys: Press to move the index to up /down/left/right.
- 6.OK: Press to enter/confirm.
- 7.EXIT: Press to exit the current page.
- 8. [In photo Multi-screen/E-book directory, press to skip the previous/next page;

In music/video directory, press to skip to the previous/ next item.


Right Side

9.OFF POWER ON: Slide the button to left /right to turn on/off the DPA

Under Side

- 10.SD/MMC/MS: Insert SD/MMC/MS card.
- 11.USB: Connect to the USB cable from the DPA to PC.
- 12. Indicator: When the DPA is connected to the power, the red indicator will be lit
- 13.DC IN: Insert the DC power adapter to the DPA player.
- 14. PHONE: Insert for earphone use.





Power Connection

Power Connection



- 1. Connect the power adapter to the DC IN 5V jack on the DPA
- 2.Plug the AC Adapter to a power jack to supply power to the DPA and charge for the built-in battery.


Note: If there is power in the built-in battery, you can use the player directly.

Don't unplug the power adaptor when the duration of charge is less than 30 minutes, or it may cause a white screen.



Connecting your DPA to your PC

Use the supplied USB cable to connect your DPA to your PC.



Note: The ASSP is a software developed by Sungale to manage the files in the Internal Memory to optimize the utilization of the source of the memory.

Start ASSP

On your computer, click "My computer", then, click "StorageDevice Disk", then, double click Fileconverter.exe, you will enter into ASSP interface.

- Tip:1. If your PC has set as auto-run, you will enter into the ASSP interface directly, no operation needed.
 - 2. The PC installed the anti-virus software or other hold-up software will make the "autorun.inf" invalid. In this situation, the file is set as hidden file. If you want to autorun the ASSP, you can set your PC to display hidden files.

Connecting your DPA to your PC

Use ASSP

1. Click "AddFile", your computer's files and folders will appear, double click the file or photo to add them to your DPA.

2. Hold on "Shift" or "Ctrl", you can download multi files or photos to your DPA.

In this way, the photos downloaded will be stored at 640X480 to suit your DPA's screen and the MP3 files will be transferred into WMA file.

When you finish the operation, safely remove the USB cable from your PC.



Tip: You also can take the DPA as a regular storage device, select the photos from your computer, then paste them in the DPA's internal memory. In this way, the photos will be stored without compression. If you want to optimize your internal memory, you can select the photos, then click the "Convert".

Attention: Once you format the internal memory of your DPA, the ASSP software will be deleted.

In this situation, you can still use the DPA as a regular storage device, and copy, paste, delete files after connecting your DPA to the PC,





Photo

Locating to the Photo Directory

I: Press the shortcut button PHOTO on the frame to display the top of the photo.
II: In the main menu, press or keep on pressing the directional buttons LEFT or RIGHT to select the item Photo. Press OK to enter the card selection interface, press the directional buttons LEFT or RIGHT to select cards, press OK to start displaying photos.





The Photos will be displayed in full screen automatically with slide show.



Press the button UP at the bottom right of the frame to skip to the previous picture. Press the button DOWN at the bottom right of the frame to skip to the next picture.



Photo

View the photo in thumbnail mode

During photo play back, press the button EXIT to enter Thumbnail Mode and browse the photos. Press the directional buttons to select the desired photos. Press OK to view the photos with slide show.



Pausing the photo

During photo play back, press OK to pause, and again to play.

Rotate

In photo slide show mode, press the directional buttons around OK to rotate the picture 90° or 180° .

In photo thumbnail mode, select the item Rotate; press the button OK repeatedly to rotate the picture counter clockwise or clockwise.

Exit

Press the EXIT button to photo browse mode, and again to the main menu.

Music

Locating to the Music Directory

i. Press the shortcut button MUSIC on the top of the frame to enter the music file list. ii. In the main menu, press or keep on pressing the directional buttons LEFT or RIGHT to select the item MUSIC. Press Ok to enter the card selection interface, press the directional button LEFT or RIGHT to select card, press Ok to play music.







Choose a song

Press the directional buttons UP or DOWN around the $\,$ OK button to select desired song in the file list.

Note: During playing and pausing, press button UP or DOWN at the bottom right of the frame to select.



Music

Playing a song

After selecting the desired song, press OK to start playing.

Pausing a song

During play back, press the OK button.

Adjusting the sound

During play back, press LEFT/RIGHT around the button OK to adjust the volume.

Exit

Press EXIT button to return to the main menu after pausing the music.

Movie

Locating to the Movie Directory

I: Press the shortcut button MOVIE to enter the movie list.

II: In the main menu, press or keep on pressing the directional buttons LEFT or RIGHT to select card, press OK to play the videos.







Press the button EXIT to enter the movie list.



Movie

Adjusting volume

Press the buttons LEFT/RIGHT around OK to increase/decrease the volume.

Exit

Press EXIT to return to the main menu.

Playing a movie

In the movie list, press the directional buttons UP/DOWN around OK to select the desired movie, press OK to start to play.

During movie play back, press the button UP/DOWN at bottom right to select the previous and next movie.

E-Book

Locating to the E-Book Directory

i. Press the shortcut button TXT on the top of the frame to enter the E-Book file list. ii. In the main menu, press or keep on pressing the directional buttons LEFT or RIGHT to select the item E-Book, Press OK to enter the card selection interface, press the directional button LEFT or RIGHT to select card, press OK to enter the eBOOK file list.







Reading a txt file

Press the directional buttons UP or DOWN around the button OK to select the desired txt file in the file list, press OK to read.

i: Upper row /Next row

Press the button UP or DOWN around OK to skip to the upper or next row.

Ii: Previous page:

Press button UP or DOWN at the bottom right of the frame to skip to the previous or next page.

Exit

Press EXIT to return to the main menu.



Photo+ Music

In the main menu, press or keep on pressing the directional buttons LEFT or RIGHT to select the item Photo+ Music, Press OK to enter the card selection interface, press the directional button LEFT or RIGHT to select card, press OK to start playing the photos with a musical slide show.





Exit

Press EXIT to return to the main menu.



In the main menu, press or keep on pressing the directional buttons LEFT or RIGHT to select the item Edit.



Press OK, you will see the following screen:



Select the items you want to edit, and press OK to enter the edit mode.



Press the buttons LEFT/RIGHT around OK to select the item Edit, and press OK. The screen will display as below:



Create a new folder

Press the buttons UP/DOWN around OK to select the item New Folder. Press OK to create a new folder.





Format Memory

Press the buttons UP/DOWN around OK to select the item Format Memory. Press OK to format the memory.

The screen will return to the previous menu automatically. If not, unplug the AC adaptor and plug again to restart.

Copy& Paste File(s)

In the file list, select a file and press OK, make sure the file in the yellow frame; to copy more files, continue select files and press OK.

Press the buttons LEFT/RIGHT around OK to select the item Edit, and press OK. The screen will display as below:



Press the buttons UP/DOWN around OK to select the item Copy. Press OK to copy a file.

Continue to press OK, the screen will display as below:



Select Paste and press OK, the desired file will be pasted. If there is already a file using the same name, you can see the Warning page:



Press OK to give up overwriting the file and return to the previous menu.



Delete File(s)

In the file list, select a file and press OK, make sure the file in the yellow frame; to delete more files, continue to select files and press OK.

Press the buttons LEFT/RIGHT around OK to select the item Edit, and press $\mathsf{OK}.$

Then press the buttons UP/DOWN around OK to select the item Delete. Press OK and select YES to delete the file(s).

SETUP

In the main menu, press or keep on pressing the directional buttons LEFT or RIGHT to select the item Setup. Press OK to enter the Setup Menu.



Photo Setting

When entering the Setup Menu, the screen will automatically display the Photo Setting:





SETUP

Press OK, and then press RIGHT button around OK to adjust the Interval Time. Press OFF to return to the previous menu.

Press OK, and then press RIGHT button around OK to adjust the Transition Effect.

Press OK, and then press RIGHT button around OK to adjust the Show Type. Press OK, and then press RIGHT button around OK to adjust the Browse Mode.

Press LEFT button around OK to return to the Photo setting menu.

Auto-play

Enter the Setup menu, press the LEFT/RIGHT button around OK to select Auto-play, press OK to enter to set up auto play Photo/ Music/ Movie.



SETUP

Display Setup

Enter the Setup menu; press the LEFT/RIGHT button around OK to select Display Setup to adjust the Color/ Brightness/ Contrast.



Custom Setup

Enter the Setup menu; press the LEFT/RIGHT button around OK to select Custom Setup to set up your custom settings mode.



Exit

Enter the Setup menu; press the LEFT/RIGHT button around OK to select the Exit item to exit the Setup Menu.

Does the player have a built-in memory?	Yes. The player has a 512MB internal memory to store media files . Do not rename the memory's name.
Can I insert multiple memory cards?	Yes, you can insert one of SD,MMC, MS card each time.
Why doesn't the picture cover the entire screen?	The resolution of the picture to cover the entire screen must be greater than 640X480 pixels.
Can the DPA player connect with all computers?	No. The USB port of the PC must be USB 2.0 and the PC must have Windows 2000 or above.
