






Power Connection

- 1. Connect the power adapter to the DC IN 5V jack on the eReader.
- Plug the AC Adapter to a power jack to supply power to the eReader and charge up the built-in battery.



Tip:

- 1. When charging up the battery, the indicator beside the DC IN 5V jack will light up as red light, after charging up the battery for about 6 hours, the indicator will turn to green light, which means that the electrification for the eReader has been finished. It can support above 3 hours picture play after being fully charged.
- 2. If there is power in the built-in battery, you can use the player directly.
- 3. Please don't unplug the power adaptor when the duration of charge is less than 30 minutes, or it may cause a white screen.

After power connection, slide the power switch to ON, after a few seconds' booing, it will enter into the interface with two choices: Link to internet or go to main menu. Touch "Go to main menu" and it will turn to main menu interface.


Cards connection

Insert one memory card each time

When inserting a memory card into the eReader, refer to the image to make sure that both the memory card and the eReader are aligned correctly (the side of the memory card on which sticker is affined should face the eReader)

SD/MMC cards are compatible with this unit. Aligning the memory card upside down may cause user-error damage. This may nullify the warranty.

When you have inserted the card correctly, there will be an SD icon appear on the right up corner of the screen.




Remove the memory card

When removing a memory card from the cyberus, press the card to release it from the card slot and pull it straight away from the unit. Avoid bending the card.



PC Connection

Use the supplied USB cable to connect your eReader to your PC.



Note: The ASSP is a software in the internal memory developed by Sungale go manage the picture and audio files to optimize the utilization of the source of the memory. The ASSP is inapplicable to manage ebook and video files. Just use the unit as a regular storage device to manage ebook and video files after connecting the unit to the PC.

Tips: 1. If your PC has set as auto-run, you will enter into the ASSP interface directly, no operation needed.

- **2.** The PC installed the anti-virus software or other hold-up software will make the "autorun.inf" invalid. In this situation, the file is set as hidden file. If you want to autorun the ASSP, you can set your PC to display hidden files.
- **3.** When connecting PC with the eReader, you can only edit files by using the PC, the eReader will not function as in normal state.

Use ASSP

- 1. Click "Add File", your computer's files and folders will appear, double click the file or photo to add them to your eReader.
- 2. Hold on "Shift" or "Ctrl", you can download multi files or photos to your eReader. In this way, the photos downloaded will be stored at 1024X768 pixels to suit your eReader screen and the MP3 files will be transferred into WMA file. When you have finished the operation, please safely remove the USB cable from your PC.

Tip: You also can take the eReader as a regular storage device, select the photos from your computer, and then paste them in the eReader's internal memory. In this way, the photos will be stored without compression. If you want to optimize your internal memory, you can select the photos, then click the "Convert".

Attention: You may find a series of files named "WMEncoder.exe", "FileConverter.exe", "encoder.exe", "Autorun.inf" and "gdiplus.dll" in the internal memory of the unit. It is the ASSP software, and not a virus. You can use it according to the instruction above.

Attention: Once you format the internal memory of your eReader, the ASSP software will be deleted.

In this situation, you can still use the eReader as a regular storage device, you can copy, paste and delete files after connecting your eReader to the PC.


After power connection, slide the power switch on, after a few seconds' booting, it will auto enter into the main menu interface. Touch "ereader" →touch internal memory or memory card→touch the book name(or file folders and then touch file) you prefer to read, there will be a Tip jumped out→touch "Yes" to enter to the file page that you read last time. Touch "No" to enter into the first page of the book selected.

Note:The eBook format should be TXT.If you have chosen PDF format, a different clue will jump out.





In the TXT format eBook reading interface, there are five icons in a row at the bottom.



eReader

Touch in and touch "yes" to set the present page as a bookmark.

Touch (a) and touch "no" to enter into the bookmark list.





There listed all bookmarks which combined by page number and the first sentence of the page that has been set as bookmark. Touch the desired bookmark to enter into the related page, touch **x** to exit.

Delete bookmark

In the bookmark list interface, touch \bigcirc and it will turn from green to orange, then touch the bookmark to select the one you would like to delete, the selected bookmark will turn to red and blue (retouch the selected bookmark that you don't want to delete, it will turn to yellow), and then touch \bigcirc to delete.






eReader

Touch eReader in the main menu, then touch internal memory or memory card to enter into the eBooks list, touch eBook name (in PDF formats),a clue will jump out: Please select an orientation. You may choose Landscape or Portrait to enter into the related mode as follow:

(Landscape)






Photo

- 1. In the main menu, touch "Photos"
- 2. Touch "INTERNAL MEMORY" or memory card name if a SD or MMC card has been inserted correctly. You will enter into picture list.
- 3. Touch the picture that you want to display. It will play the picture and after 5 seconds without any operation on the screen, it will play the picture in full screen.
- 4. If you prefer to play picture one by one automatically, touch the 📵 .



(step show mode)



If you prefer to add background music when playing the pictures, you may touch the screen, and touch \bigcirc , then touch \bigcirc to play picture one by one with background music.

Photo

Moving pictures

If the screen doesn't show the whole picture, you may touch the picture's left/right/up/down erea (as shown in the picture below) to see the whole picture.



But sometimes you may need to set up display mode first. Back to the main menu, touch "Setting" \rightarrow touch "display" \rightarrow touch "optimal" and then touch \times to back to the main menu.





Then you can touch the left or right or up and down area of the picture to see the whole picture.

Touch the center of the screen to exit.

Photo

Attention: When the picture is in full screen display,

- 1. If there is black area beside anyside of the picture, then the picture won't move when you touch any side of the picture.
- 2. If the picture whose resolution is 240 X400pixels is in full screen display, the picture won't move.
- 3. If the picture's width and height proportion is 800:480 pixels, then the picture won't move.

The picture moving rule also applies to Picasa picture show.

Music

In the main menu, touch "A/V" → touch internal memory or memory card, you will enter into the audio and video name list.

Touch the desired music name to start playing. You may enter into the name list with music files only,and the selected music is playing at the bottom of the screen.

Stand for music files.





When playing, touch u to pause, then touch to continue playing. Touch to make it mute, touch to turn down the volume, touch to turn up.

When you have touched repeatedly until you see \times , you should touch to recover the voice. Touch \times on the right up corner to exit.

Note: 1.The playing mode is: repeat all music files.

2. When the machine is playing one song, and you want to change another song, you need to touch x to exit to the music name list, then touch the song you want to play.

Video

In the main menu, touch "A/V"→touch internal memory or memory card to enter into the video and audio file list.



Touch the desired file to start playing, stand for movie files. In the video playing interface, there are several icons below: turn to be mute/reinstate the sound, turn the volume down, turn the volume up.

When you have touched \blacksquare repeatedly until you see k, you should touch \blacksquare to recover the voice.



Note: After playing one video, it will auto return to the video list interface.

Edit files

(Files including eBook files, photos, audios and videos)

Copy and paste

- Step 1. When you have entered the eBook (including the bookmarks) /photo/music/video file list interface, touch ⊘ it will turn from green to orange, then touch the files you prefer to copy(the selected files will turn to red and blue. If you don't want to copy the selected file, please retouch it.)
- **Step 2.** Touch \mathbf{X} to exit, then enter into the folder that you want to copy the files to
- Step 3. Touch (a) to start paste.
- **Step 4.** After pasting, the files you have copied will be listed in the playing list.





Delete

- Step 1. When you have entered the eBook (including the bookmarks) /photo/music/video file list interface, touch , it will turn from green to orange, then touch the files you prefer to delete (the selected files will turn to red and blue. If you don't want to delete the selected file, please retouch it.)
- Step 2. Touch 🗊 to start deleting.

Note pad

In the main menu, touch "Note pad" to enter into the note list interface, which list the subjects of the recent 6 notes, touch any subject, its related note content and remind date would appear on the screen.

Note: There might be no note list at the very beginning of purchase

Add new note

Touch set up remind time and date. After setting the time and date by touching the four directional icon, touch to input subject and note content.







Then touch | to confirm and back to the note list interface.

Delete note

In the note list interface, touch the note you would like to delete, there will be a " * " in front of the note, then touch 📑 to delete directly. Touch 🗶 to exit.

Clock

Clock, calendar and alarm clock setting:

In the main menu, touch "Clock" to enter into the interface with clock and calendar, touch the directional icons to browse the calendar.



Touch the set up date, time and alarm clock. After setting, touch X to exit. When set up alarm clock, please make sure that the state is "ON"



When time for alarm clock is up, there will be clock appear on the screen with alarm bell ringing, touch the screen to back to the main menu.

Attention: Please make sure that the machine is working when alarm time is up. Or else the alarm clock won't work.

Dictionary

In the main menu, touch "DICT" to enter into the following interface:



Input the word by touch the keyboard on the screen.



Then touch ← to confirm, it will go to the explanation interface.

Touch ♦ to turn pages. Touch ★ to exit.

Setting

In the main menu, touch setting to set up items as follow:

Slide show time

5s, 10s, 15s optional, touch the time you want then it will auto return to the last interface.

Slide show mode

Touch to set up display mode: optimal, original

Touch "others" to enter into the interface with two choices:

- 1. Default: touch to recover the machine's setting to the original state
- 2. info: touch to find the version of the eReader and MAC ID information, etc.

Setting

Network setting

There are three methods for you to access to network setting which including the first interface after power connection "Link to Internet" and "Setting→network" as well as when you operate functions that need successfully network linking.

The first method

Take the first interface after power connection for example. After power connection and the player has been turned on. You will see the following interface: Link to Internet and Go to main menu.



Touch "Link to Internet".



Setting

You may get the following results

Situation 1. No routers have been found.

At this situation, you may move the machine closer to the router or your PC. And you may also check if your router is open.



Situation 2. There are several routers listed on the interface for your choice.



If there's a lock before the router name, it means that you need to input password of the router.

"ill shows the strength of router's signal.More signal will help you link to network easier.

Setting

In the routers list, touch the router name you want and then touch "Yes".



If you have chosen a router which has a lock, you need to input password for it.





You can use the keyboard to input password (Only numbers and letters are acceptable) When finished inputting password, touch — to confirm.

Then you will enter into a interface with two choice:


- 1. Auto IP with DHCP (Choose this option will be more convenient)

Touch "No" to back to the main menu, and you may not be able to use those functions until successful network link.



After link to the internet successfully, you will enter into the following interface.



Touch "Continue" and then enjoy the Wi-Fi functions.

Weather

Attention: All the functions mentioned below are based on the premise that you have successfully linked to the internet.

In the main menu, touch "Weather" to enter into the following interface:

There are two ways to get the weather information:

1. Input city name or local zip code and then touch





2.Touch "Browse for U.S.and International Forecasts" to enter the country list interface.

Touch the numbers and country name to enter into related city name list. Touch the city's name to get the weather information.

Touch X to exit.

Note: There listed almost all the country and main city names. When you touch some of the country names or city names, there might be no record, and the interface may show the reason of failure such as: Failed to download the cities of this country.

IP Radio

Attention: All the functions mentioned below are based on the premise that you have successfully linked to the internet.

- **Step 1.** In the main menu, touch "IP Radio" to enter into the country list interface. During this process, there might be a clue show that "Connecting network..." Please wait for a while in this situation.
- Step 2. Touch country name to enter into city name lists.
- **Step 3.** Touch city name to enter into radio lists.
- **Step 4.** Touch radio to enter into the following interface:



Touch to turn mute or reinstate to normal play, Touch or to decrease or increase the volume.

IP Radio

Add stations to "My favorite"

1. In the radio list interface, touch and it will turn from green to orange, touch the radio you prefer to add to "My favorite", then touch to add the radio to "My favorite"



2. In the radio list of My favorite, touch (a) input the radio's name and address, then touch (b) to confirm. Now the radio has been added to "My favorite".



Delete stations

In the radio list of "My favorite",touch \bigcirc and then touch the radio you want to delete, touch \bigcirc to delete.

News

Attention: All the functions mentioned below are based on the premise that you have successfully linked to the internet.

In the main menu, touch "News" to enter the interface with two choices: Google and Yahoo

Take "Google" news for example

Touch "Google" to enter into the interface as follow:



Touch the item you would like to read, it will enter into the interface as follow:



Touch ⟨ ⟩ to browse the previous or the next news, touch ∇ to turn pages.

YouTube

Attention: All the functions mentioned below are based on the premise that you have successfully linked to the internet.

In the main menu, touch "YouTube" to enter into the interface with two choice above: Video and Most Viewed Videos

Touch "Most viewed videos" to enter into the interface with four choices: Today, This week, This Month, All time

Touch the item you prefer to watch, You may enter into the interface with 3 icons below: Browse previous video, play, browse next video.



Then touch or the picture of the video to start play. At this time, you may need time to connect the network, please wait for a while patiently. Touch to exit.

YouTube

Watch you own YouTube

After connecting to the network successfully, touch the YouTube icon in the main menu to enter into the interface with three options: Video, Most Viewed Videos and My YouTube.

Touch "My YouTube" to enter into the interface showed in picture 1:

Input your user name by using the keyboard below and then touch —, you will enter into the interface which listed your YouTube programs (only one video files will be showed on the screen at a time), and there are three icons at the bottom (Please refer to picture 2).

Touch \bigcirc or \bigcirc to browse previous or next video.

Touch **()** to play the present video.

At this time, you may need to wait for a while patiently to connect network.

Touch X to exit.

Tip1: My YouTube is a convenient tool by which you may watch the videos that you have collected and share them with your friends.

Tip2: You should own a registered user name on YouTube before using "My YouTube"

Gmail

Attention: All the functions mentioned below are based on the premise that you have successfully linked to the internet.

In the main menu, touch "Gmail" to enter the log in interface of Gmail. Input the user name and password then touch $\begin{tabular}{c} \leftarrow \end{tabular}$ to enter into you e-mail receiving box.



Touch \bigcirc \bigcirc to read the previous or next email. Touch \nearrow to exit.



Picasa


Attention: All the functions mentioned below are based on the premise that you have successfully linked to the internet.





You may touch Query Record in the interface showed in Picture 1,it will show all the route records that you have inquired before.

Screen calibration

If the touch screen doesn't work or doesn't work correctly, you may need to adjust it through the following operation:

Step 1. In the main menu, keep pressing (the right button on the frame)until "ereader" is selected and turn to yellow, then keep pressing (the right button on the frame)five times. An interface as follow will appear:



Firstly the "+" will appear at the left down corner, after touching exactly the very center point of the "+"quickly, it will go to the left up corner, then keep touching the center point of the "+", it will go to the right up corner, right down corner and center of the screen respectively. After five times exact and quick touch in order, the screen calibration will be finished and auto return to the main menu interface.

Tips:

- 1. Please adjust the screen by using touch screen stick in order to touch exactly.
- 2. Please make sure that you are touching the very center of the "+" exactly. Please touch quickly or else it will be taken as touch twice, then the "+" will not appear in order and you may need to do it again until you have done correctly.
- 3. If you can not make it and you want to exit from the interface, the only way is to turn the power off and then on.
