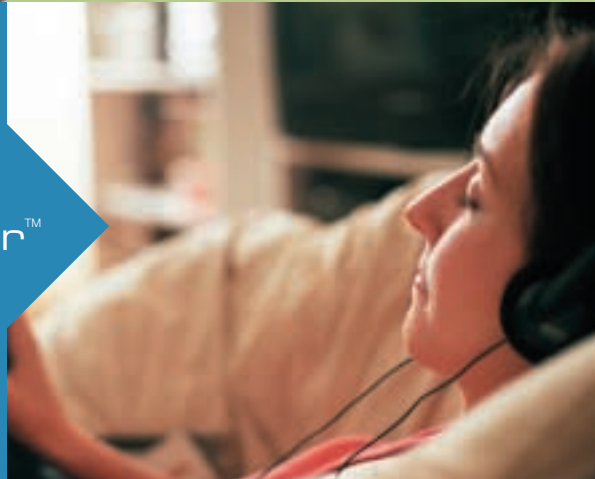

Designed for people who have a visual impairment or learning disability, this DAISY CD Player also accepts standard audio and talking book CDs and MP3 CDs. The Scholar is lightweight and sleek in appearance with the primary controls easily identified by their larger size and tactile rubber construction, while secondary controls are smaller and feature a silver finish. The player will provide instant access to specific page numbers and chapters in the DAISY structure, and includes a full numeric keypad with bookmarking feature. An LCD screen displays disc details for "at a glance" teacher monitoring, and lightweight headphones are included.

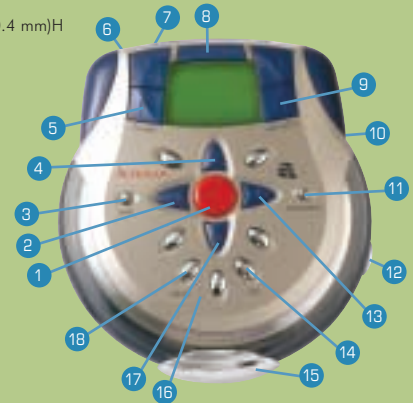

| 3 | Page | Use this Key to End a Page Number Entry |
| 4 | Up Arrow | Navigate to a Higher Book Level (i.e. from Section Level to Main Chapter Level) |
| 5 | Volume Up/Down | Increase or Decrease Volume to Headphones |
| 6 | DC Input | Jack for DC Input |
| 7 | I/O Port | Used for future upgrades |
| 8 | Undo/Redo | Press to Return to the Previous Navigation Point/Press Again to Return to the Navigation Point Entered |
| 9 | Variable Speed | Increases or Decreases Playing Speed |
| 10 | Headphone Jack | Jack for Headphones |
| 11 | Bookmark | Use this Key to End a "Set" or "Go To" Bookmark Entry |
| 12 | Hold Switch | In "Hold" Prevents Unit from Accidental Power when Unit is Off or Interrupting Playback when Unit is Playing |
| 13 | Skip/Search Forward | Press Momentarily to Play the Next Track/Hold to Preview Audio Forward |
| 14 | Set | Press this Button to Begin the Entry of a Numbered Bookmark |
| 15 | Door Clamp | Allows Access to the CD and the Internal Battery Compartments |
| 16 | Numeric Key Pad | |
| 17 | Down Arrow | Navigate to a Lower Book Level (i.e. from Main Chapter Level to Section Level) |
| 18 | Go To | Press this Button to Begin the Sequence of a Page or Bookmark Entry |
