

Setting up the DocuPrint M115 z printer on a wireless network



### Before you begin

Ensure you have the **name of your** wireless network (SSID), wireless network password, security and encryption types.

To find the name and type of security encryption of your wireless network on your computer (example Windows 7):

- a) Go to the Start Menu. Select Control Panel and click on Network and Sharing Centre.
- b) Click on **Manage Wireless Networks.** Double click on your preferred wireless network. Note the SSID. Click on the security tab. Note the security and encryption types.


## **WPS-PBC** (WPS Button)

Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS) is a network security standard that allow users to easily secure a wireless home network, and connect wireless client devices (iPad's etc.) to it, without accessing the router's configuration screens, and without even knowing the wireless network's security key/passphrase.

NOTE: A WPS-PBC enabled wireless access point is required. Please refer to the manual provided with the router.


Before starting WPS-PBC, confirm the position of the WPS button on the wireless access point or router. Please refer to the manual provided with the router.

Press the [Wi-Fi/WPS] button on the printer control panel.



Press the number [1] on the keypad.

'Connecting WLAN' is displayed whilst the connection is established.



**NOTE:** There is a 2 minute time-out to complete the setup procedure

- Complete the WPS-PBC procedure on the wireless access point.
- 'Connected' is displayed when the wireless connection is successfully established and a 'WLAN Report' will be printed. The [Wi-Fi/WPS] button will also be lit solid green.





NOTE: A WPS-PIN enabled wireless access point is required.


1 Press the [Menu] button on the printer control panel.




2 Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select [Network], and then press the [OK] button.



Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select [WLAN], and then press the [OK] button.



Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select [WPS w/PIN Code], and then press the [OK] button.




- Press the number [1] on the keypad.
- **6 'Connecting WPS'** and the PIN are displayed.
- Complete the WPS-PIN setup procedure on the wireless access point. Please refer to the manual provided with the router.

**NOTE:** There is a 2 minute time-out to complete the setup


'Connected' is displayed when the wireless connection is successfully established and a 'WLAN Report' will be printed. The [Wi-Fi/WPS] button will also be lit solid green.

**Auto SSID** 


Press the [Menu] button on the printer control panel.



2 Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select [Network], and then press the [OK] button.



Use the [**Up**] or [**Down**] arrow buttons to select [1. WLAN], and then press the [OK] button.




Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select [3. Setup Wizard], and then press the [OK] button.



## Wifi Setup


- Press the number [1] on the keypad to confirm enabling wireless.
- 'Searching SSID' is displayed whilst the printer searches for available wireless networks.
- Use the [**Up**] or [**Down**] arrow buttons to select the correct SSID and then press the [OK] button. 'Network Key' is displayed.
- Use the Number Pad keys on the Control Panel to enter the Network Key (Password)., and then press the [OK] button.
- Press the number [1] on the keypad to apply settings.
- **Connecting WLAN** is displayed whilst the connection is established.




'Connected' is displayed when the wireless connection is successfully established and a 'WLAN Report' will be printed. The [Wi-Fi/WPS] button will also be lit solid green.




Press the [Menu] button on the control panel.




Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select [Network], and then press the [OK] button.




3 Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select [WLAN], and then press the [OK] button.



4 Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select [Setup Wizard], and then press the [OK] button.



- Press the number [1] on the keypad to confirm enabling
- 'Searching SSID' is displayed whilst the printer searches for available wireless networks.
- Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select [<New SSID>], and then press the [OK] button.



- Use the Number Pad keys on the Control Panel to enter the Wireless Network SSID. Use the [Right] arrow button to move to the next character position. When the Wireless Network SSID is entered, press the [OK] button.
- Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select Network Mode', and then press the [OK] button.



- 11 Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select 'Encryption Type', and then press the [OK] button.



- Use the Number Pad keys on the Control Panel to enter the 'Network Key' (Password). When the Wireless Network key is entered, press the [OK] button.
- 13 Press the number [1] on the keypad to appply settings.
- **14 Connecting WLAN** is displayed whilst the connection is established





## Reset Wireless Network Settings


Press the [Menu] button on the control panel.



Use the [Up] or [Down] arrow buttons to select [Network], and then press the [OK] button.



Use the [**Up**] or [**Down**] arrow buttons to select [Netwrok Reset], and then press the [OK] button.



- 4 Press the number [1] button on the keypad to confirm reset.
- 5 Press the number [1] button on the keypad to confirm reboot.
- 'Accepted' will temporarily be displayed, then 'Please Wait' will be displayed while the printer reboots.
