#	Icon	Item	Description
1		Acer Crystal Eye webcam	Web camera for video communication.
2		Microphone	Internal microphone for sound recording.








#	Icon	Item	Description
3		Display screen	Also called Liquid-Crystal Display (LCD), displays computer output (Configuration may vary by models).
4		Power button / indicator	Turns the computer on and off. / Indicates the computer's power status.
5		Keyboard	For entering data into your computer.
6		Touchpad	Touch-sensitive pointing device which functions like a computer mouse.
7		Click buttons (left and right)	The left and right buttons function like the left and right mouse buttons.
8		Palmrest	Comfortable support area for your hands when you use the computer.
9		Touchpad toggle	Turns the internal touchpad on and off.
10		Communication key	Enables / disables the WLAN / 3G function.
		Backup key	Launches Acer Backup Management for three-step data backup.
		Acer PowerSmart key	Puts your computer into power-saving mode.
		HDD	Indicates when the hard disk drive is active.
11		Speakers	Left and right speakers deliver stereo audio output.

Hotkeys

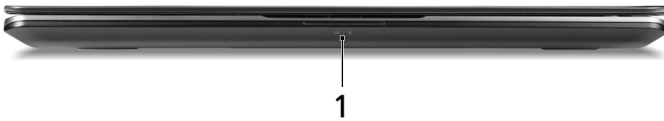
The computer employs hotkeys or key combinations to access most of the computer's controls like screen brightness and volume output.


To activate hotkeys, press and hold the **<Fn>** key before pressing the other key in the hotkey combination.

Hotkey	Icon	Function	Description
<Fn> + <F2>		System property	Starts System Property for displaying system information.
<Fn> + <F3>		Bluetooth	Enables/disables the Bluetooth function. (only for certain models)
<Fn> + <F4>		Sleep	Puts the computer in Sleep mode.

Hotkey	Icon	Function	Description
<Fn> + <F5>		Display toggle	Switches display output between the display screen, external monitor (if connected) and both.
<Fn> + <F6>		Screen blank	Turns the display screen backlight off to save power. Press any key to return.
<Fn> + <F8>		Speaker toggle	Turns the speakers on and off.
<Fn> + <↵>		Brightness up	Increases the screen brightness.
<Fn> + <⇐>		Brightness down	Decreases the screen brightness.
<Fn> + <△>		Volume up	Increases the sound volume.
<Fn> + <▽>		Volume down	Decreases the sound volume.

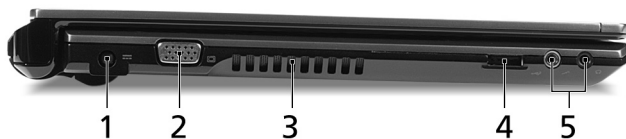
#	Icon	Item	Description
1		Battery	Indicates the computer's battery status. 1. Charging: The light shows amber when the battery is charging. 2. Fully charged: The light shows blue when in AC mode.

#	Icon	Item	Description
1		Battery bay	Houses the computer's battery pack.

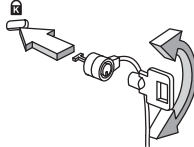


#	Icon	Item	Description
1		DC-in jack	Connects to an AC adapter.
2		External display (VGA) port	Connects to a display device (e.g., external monitor, LCD projector).
3		Ventilation slots	Enable the computer to stay cool, even after prolonged use.
4		USB 2.0 port	Connect to USB 2.0 devices (e.g., USB mouse, USB camera).
5		Microphone-in jack	Accepts inputs from external microphones.
		Headphones/speaker/line-out jack with S/PDIF support	Connects to audio line-out devices (e.g., speakers, headphones).

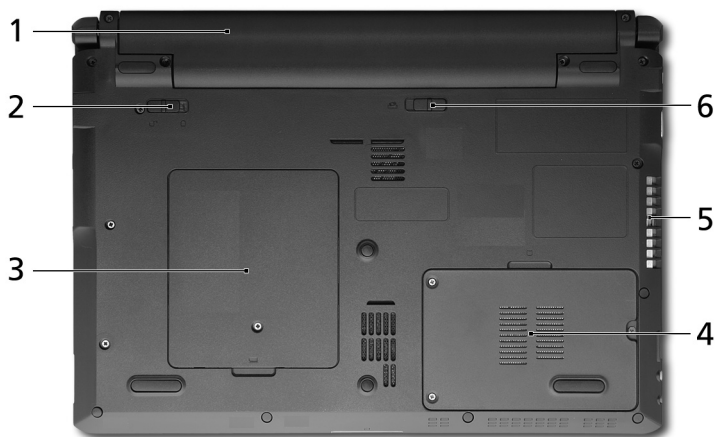

#	Icon	Item	Description
1		5-in-1 card reader	<p>Accepts Secure Digital (SD), MultiMediaCard (MMC), Memory Stick (MS), Memory Stick PRO (MS PRO), xD-Picture Card (xD).</p> <p>Note: Push to remove/install the card. Only one card can operate at any given time.</p>
2		USB 2.0 port	Connects to USB 2.0 devices (e.g., USB mouse, USB camera).
3	HDMI	HDMI port	Supports high definition digital video connections.
4		Ethernet (RJ-45) port	Connects to an Ethernet 10/100/1000-based network.
5		Kensington lock slot	<p>Connects to a Kensington-compatible computer security lock.</p> <p>Note: Wrap the computer security lock cable around an immovable object such as a table or handle of a locked drawer. Insert the lock into the notch and turn the key to secure the lock. Some keyless models are also available.</p>

#	Icon	Item	Description
1		Battery bay	Houses the computer's battery pack.
2		Battery lock	Locks the battery in position.
3		Memory compartment	Houses the computer's main memory.
4		Hard disk bay	Houses the computer's hard disk (secured with screws).
5		Ventilation slots and cooling fan	Enable the computer to stay cool, even after prolonged use. Note: Do not cover or obstruct the opening of the fan.
6		Battery release latch	Releases the battery for removal.
