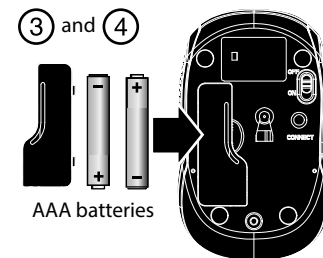
### Installing the batteries and removing the nano receiver

- 1 Take the battery cover off.
- 2 Remove the nano receiver.



- 3 Insert the batteries as shown inside the battery compartment.
- 4 Replace the cover.

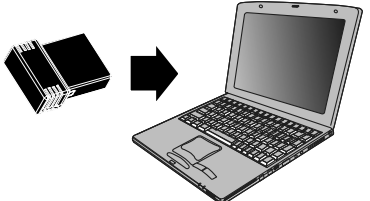
**Caution:** Insert the battery with the correct orientation, according to the instruction label on the mouse.

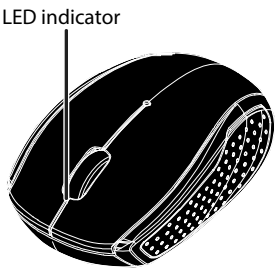
# Setting up the connection between the receiver and the mouse

1 Plug the nano receiver into a USB port on your computer.



- 2 If the mouse does not work, do the following:  
 Re-plug the nano receiver into the USB port on your computer, then press the connect button on the mouse. If the mouse does not work after 10 seconds, pair them again by pressing the connect button on the mouse. (The nano receiver has auto-pairing function).
- 3 The LED indicator on the mouse flashes steadily when it is in pairing mode and stops blinking when it is successfully paired with the nano receiver.
- 4 When the battery power gets low, the battery indicator on the mouse will start to blink.

## Mouse indicator



Power ON	LED is on for 10 sec.
Low battery warning	LED blinks for 10 sec.
Pairing	LED blinks.
When paired or failed after 10 sec.	LED is off.

## Cleaning your mouse

- Wipe the mouse with a damp, lint-free cloth.

## Troubleshooting

- Make sure that your computer meets the system requirements.
- Only use the mouse on a clean, flat, non-slippery surface to ensure smooth and accurate cursor action.
- If your mouse stops working:
  - Make sure your mouse and nano receiver are paired by pressing the connect button on the mouse.
  - Replace the mouse batteries.
- Avoid using your mouse on reflective, transparent, or metallic surfaces.
