ADJUSTABLE TAPER LEVER

1. With a screwdriver or a dime, turn the power screw counterclockwise until the arm strikes a coil, making a clacking noise (Fig. 1).
 2. Turn the screw clockwise until the noise stops, and then turn about 45 degrees more. This is the maximum power setting (Fig. 2).
1. Packed-in hair can slow down any clipper. To remove hair without removing the blades, use your cleaning brush to brush hair out of the blades. This should be done after each use. When blades are free of hair, apply a small amount of oil across them.
2. Turn the screw clockwise until the noise stops, and then turn about 45 degrees more. This is the maximum power setting (Fig. 2).

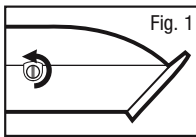

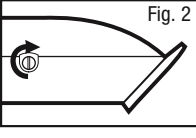
TORNILLO REGULADOR DE ENERGÍA

El tornillo regulador de energía permite ajustar la potencia del aparato, lo que puede ser necesario si la electricidad en su casa está baja (la cortadora Conair® ha sido diseñada para uso doméstico).

1. Gire el tornillo en sentido horario con un destornillador o una moneda (Fig.1) hasta que la armadura choque con la bobina, produciendo un sonido continuo.



2. Gire el tornillo en sentido antihorario hasta que el sonido se detenga. Entonces, gire el tornillo 45 grados más. Esto es el ajuste de energía máximo (Fig.2).

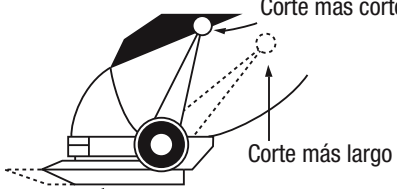


PALANCA REGULADORA DE CORTE

Al igual que las cortadoras profesionales, su cortadora está equipada con una palanca reguladora ajustable al nivel del pulgar que permite ajustar el largo del corte a medida que corta el cabello.

La palanca reguladora permite cortar el cabello más corto o más largo, sin tener que instalar una guía. Para obtener un corte más corto, deslice el botón hacia arriba, hasta la posición 1. Para obtener un corte más largo, deslice la palanca hacia abajo. El ajuste más bajo dejará el cabello tan corto como la guía más corta.

Usar la palanca reguladora prolonga la vida útil de las cuchillas, puesto que éstas nunca utilizan el mismo ángulo para cortar.



Su cortadora puede perder velocidad si recortes de cabello están trabados en las cuchillas. Para limpiar las cuchillas sin tener que removerlas, use el cepillo de limpieza provisto. Haga esto después de cada uso. Después de limpiar las cuchillas, lubríquelas con un poco de aceite.

Hacer esto después de cada uso, especialmente cuando se corta mucho cabello, mantendrá las cuchillas en condición óptima. Si la cortadora deja de funcionar y que esto no soluciona el problema, examine las cuchillas. Si están embotadas, cámbielas. 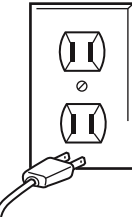
