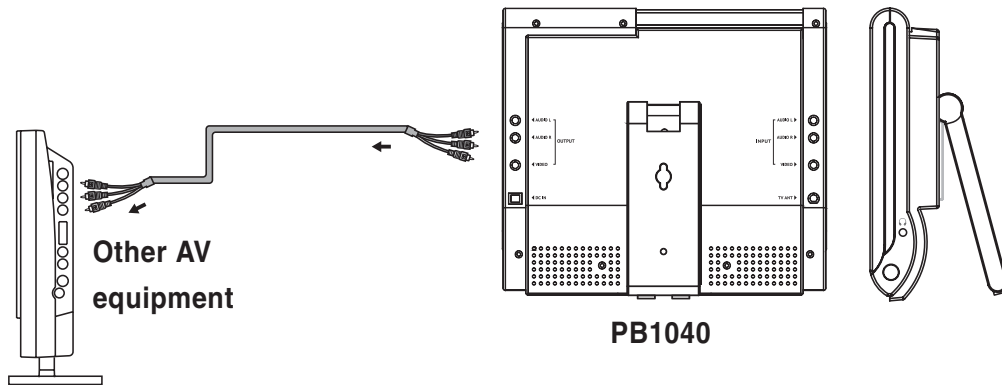
INPUT (RCA) AV

2. Connect your AV cable to the equipment as shown below.



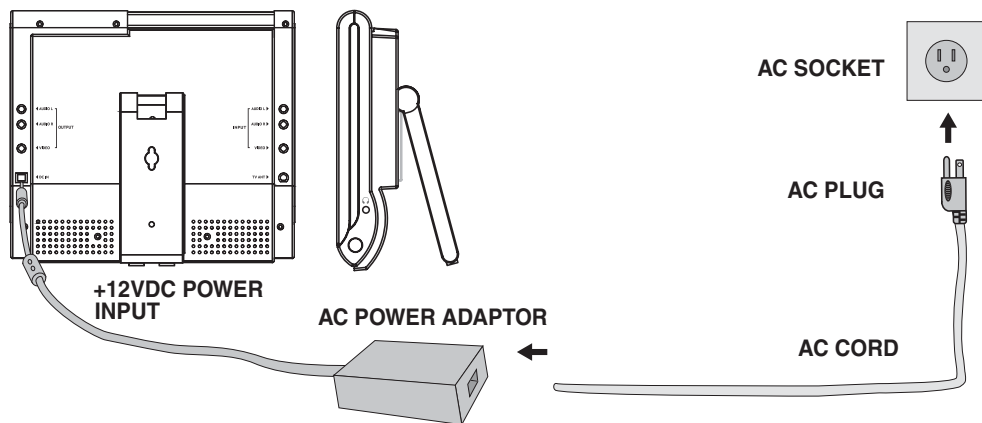
OUTPUT (RCA) AV

Connect the output signal from the PB1040 as shown below.



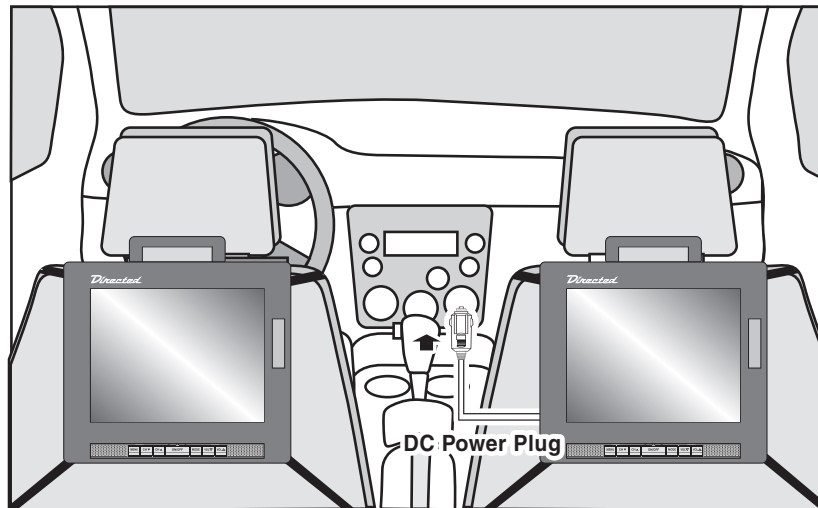
POWER CONNECTION (AC)

POWER CONNECTION (DC)—IN VEHICLE

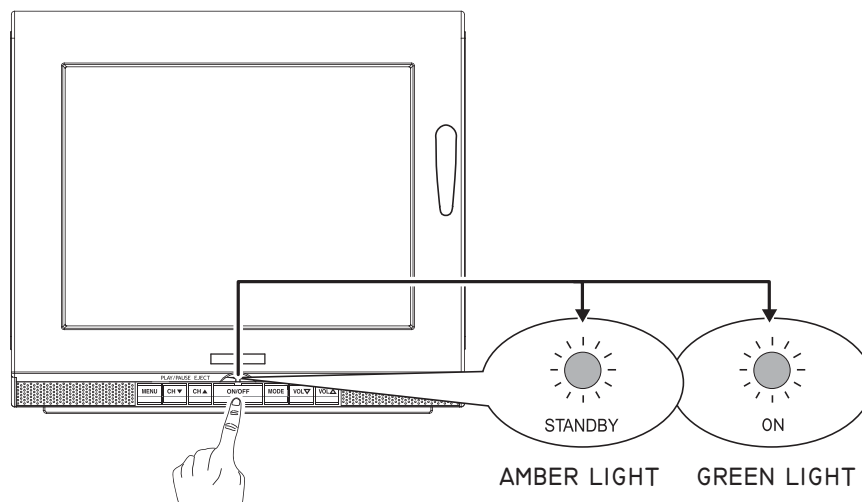

Basic Functions

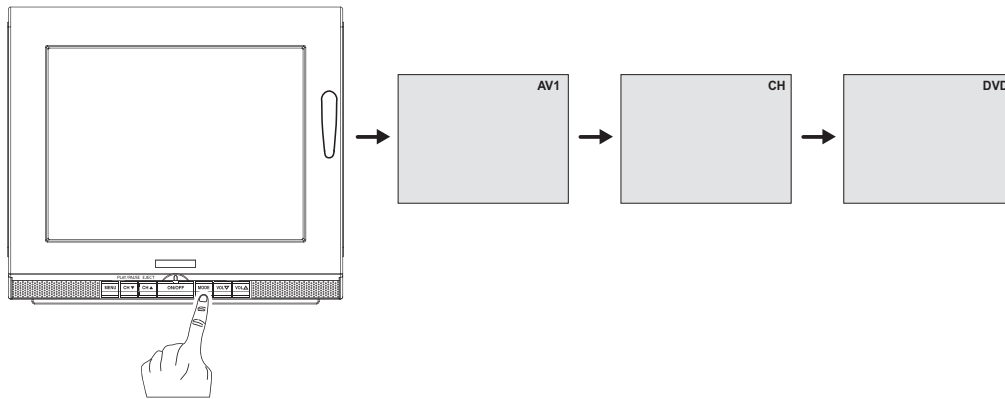
POWER ON/OFF

1. The Power indicator LED on the bottom of the front panel turns Amber in color when power is connected.
2. Press the **On/Off** button on the front control panel, or the Power button on the remote, the Power indicator LED on the front panel will turn Green in color.



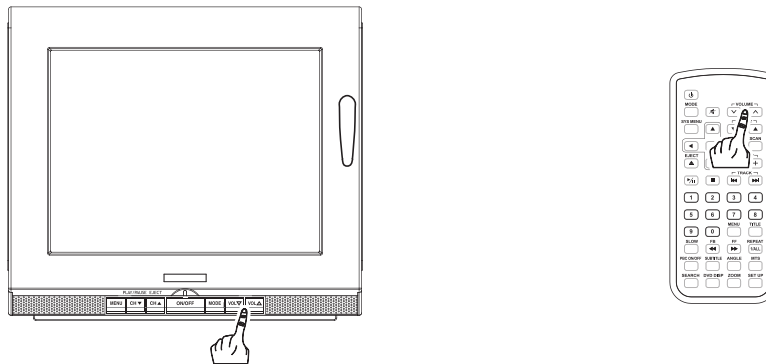
MODE

1. Press the **Mode** button on the remote or the **Mode** button on the front control panel to select from the various mode settings.
2. The mode setting status will change each time the **Mode** button is pressed—**AV1 - CH - DVD**.



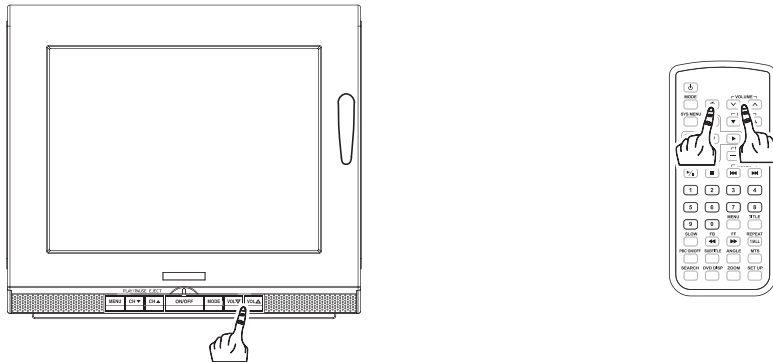
VOLUME

Press the **Vol** ∇/Δ buttons on the front control panel or the Volume ∇/Δ buttons on the remote control to adjust the volume level.



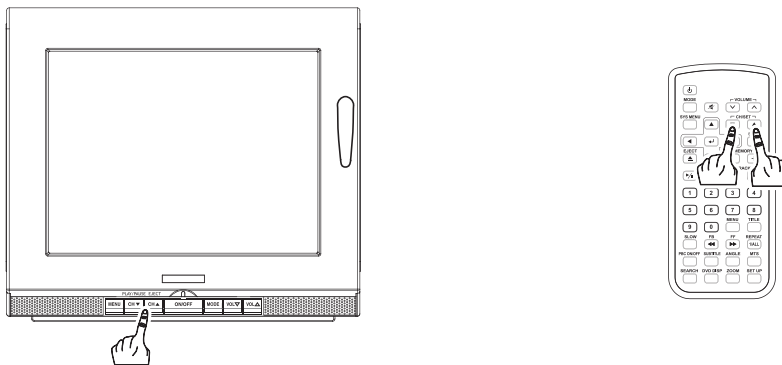
MUTE

1. Press the **Mute** button on the remote control to mute the speakers.

CHANNEL CHANGE

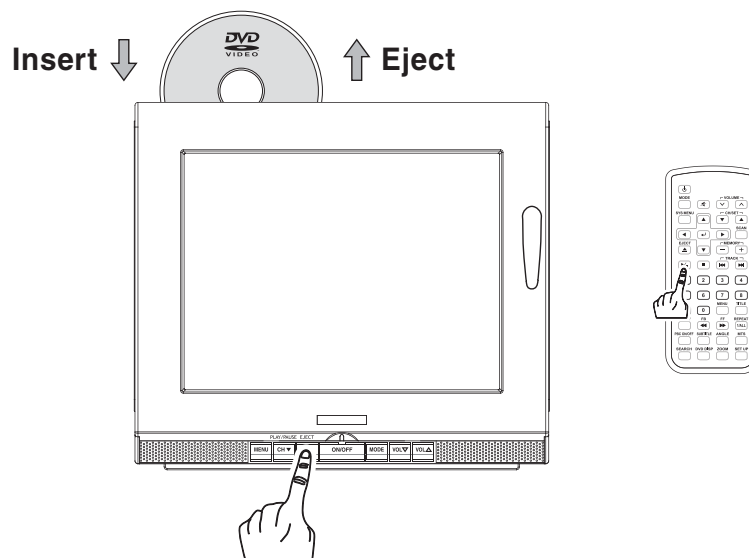
1. Press the **CH/SET ▼/▲** button on the remote control or the ▼/▲ button front control panel to change television channels.
















PLAYING DVD/CD/MP3

1. Press the **On/Off** power button on the front control panel, or press the  button on the remote control to switch on the unit
2. Press **Mode** button on the remote control repeatedly until DVD mode is displayed.
3. Insert the disc into the DVD player as shown in the illustration below.

NOTE: To avoid damaging discs, insert the disc into the slot with the disc parallel to the slot.



4. The disc will automatically start playing.
 - If the DVD does not come with a Menu/Title, the play will continue.
 - If the DVD comes with Menu/Title, Menu Options will be shown on the screen, press the **Left/Right/Up/Down** () buttons on the remote control, to select the chapter for playing, press the **Enter** () button on the remote to begin play.
 - If the message "NO DISC" is displayed on the screen, check the format of the disc being used and ensure that the disc is being loaded with the label facing you (see illustration above).
 - If the message "WRONG REGION" is display on the screen, it means the player does not support the regional code for that DVD.
5. Press the **Left/Right/Up/Down** () button on the remote to select the chapter to be played.
6. Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** (**CH**) button on the front control panel or the play/pause () button on the remote to begin play (you can also use the **ENTER** () button on the remote).

EJECTING DVD/CD/MP3

1. Press the **MODE** button on the front panel or the **MODE** button on the remote control to select DVD mode.
2. Press the **EJECT (CH▲)** button on the front control panel or the **EJECT ▲** button on the remote to eject the DVD from the player.

TV STATION MEMORY MODE

1. Press **MODE** button on the remote control repeatedly until TV mode is displayed.
2. Select a channel to be viewed by pressing the channel **CH (▼/▲)** buttons on the front panel or the **CH/SET (▼/▲)** buttons on the remote control.
3. Press the **ENTER (↵)** button on the remote control, the main menu option will display on the screen as shown below. This allows you to memorize the stations into the LCD monitor.

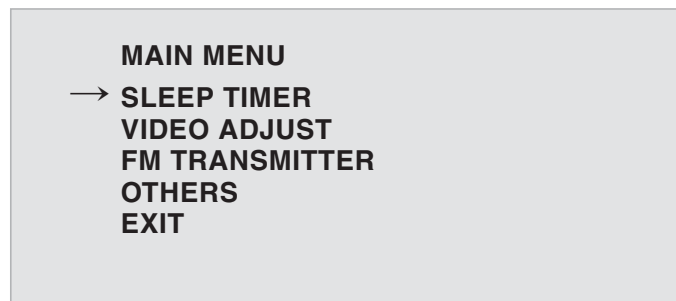

3. Use the Up/Down (**▼/▲**) buttons on the remote to select the memory number to be set (maximum 15).
4. Press the **ENTER (↵)** button on the remote control to return to viewing the TV channel. This memory slot has now been “memorized” to this TV channel.
5. Repeat the above steps (2–4) to set all 15 favorite TV channels.
6. Use the **MEMORY (-)** and **(+)** buttons on the remote control to select the favorite TV channels.

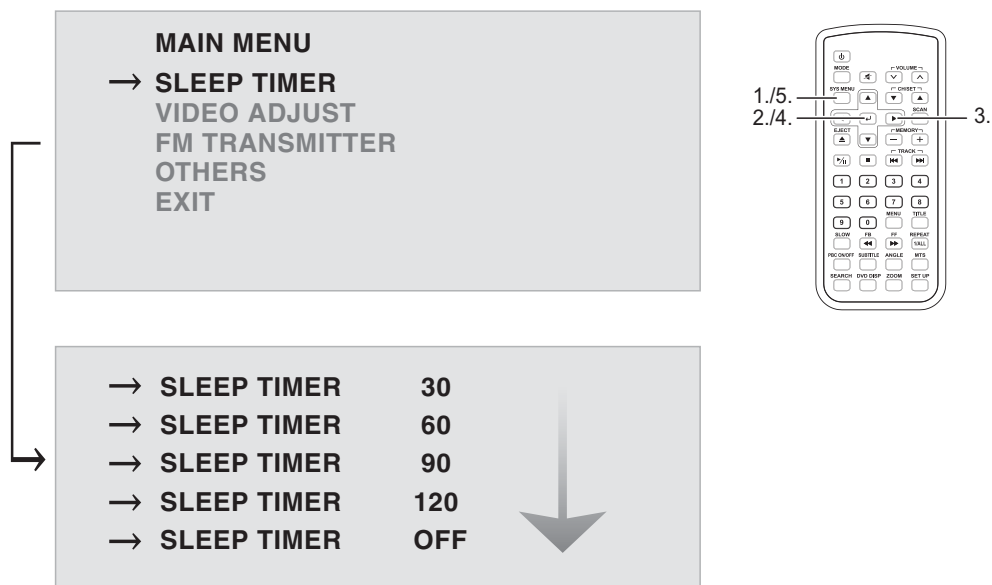

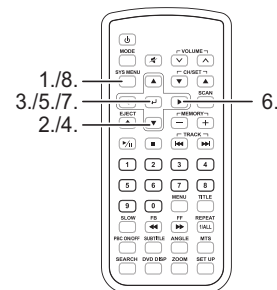
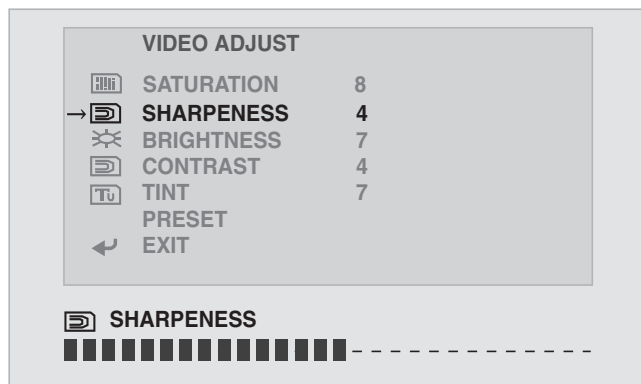
SLEEP TIMER

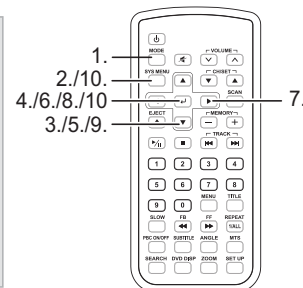
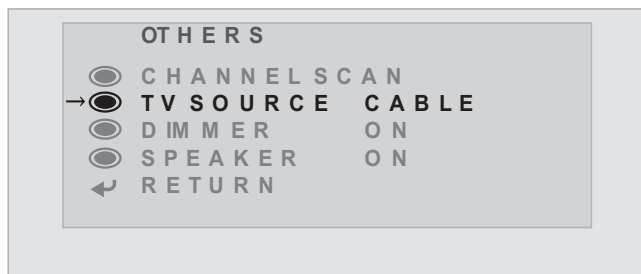
CHANNEL SCAN

7. Press the **MENU** button on front control panel or the **ENTER (↵)** button on remote to save the selection.
8. Press the **Vol ▽/▲** buttons on front control panel or the Up/Down (**▼/▲**) buttons on remote to select RETURN.
9. Press the **MENU** button on front control panel or the **ENTER (↵)** button on remote to return to the MAIN MENU. Or, press the **SYS MENU** button on the remote to exit the menus.



DVD Operation

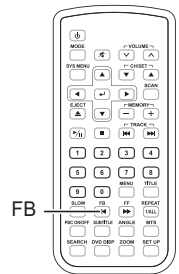

1. During play, press the **FF** button on the remote control.
2. For DVDs and MP3s, the LCD screen will display FF XX (Fast-Forward Speed), and will increment up to a maximum of 8X fast forward (2X, 4X, 6X, 8X) and then to normal play speed.
3. For CDs, the LCD screen will display FF XX (Fast-Forward Speed), and will increment up to a maximum of 4X fast forward (1X, 2X, 3X, 4X) and then to normal play speed.
4. For DVDs, MP3s and CDs press play/pause (▶/⏸) from any fast forward speed to resume normal play speed.



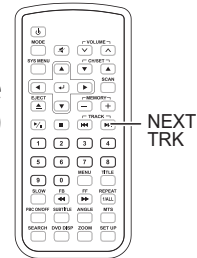

1. During play, press the **FB** button on the remote control.
2. For DVDs and MP3s, the LCD screen will display FR XX (Fast-Forward Speed), and will increment up to a maximum of 8X fast backward (2X, 4X, 6X, 8X) and then to normal play speed.
3. For CDs, the LCD screen will display FR XX (Fast-Forward Speed), and will increment up to a maximum of 4X fast backward (1X, 2X, 3X, 4X) and then to normal play speed.
4. For DVDs, MP3s and CDs press play/pause (▶/⏸) from any fast backward speed to resume normal play speed.



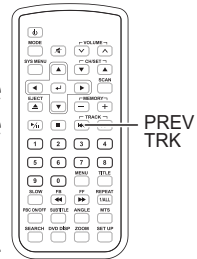

DVD ANGLE

Some DVDs support different viewing angles for the same scene. Press the **ANGLE** button on the remote control to select a viewing angle.

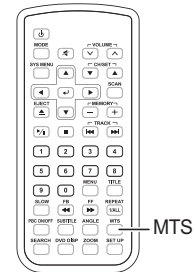

Appendix A – Cleaning

CLEANING THE LCD SCREEN

CAUTION: To avoid possible shock hazard and equipment damage, be sure the LCD system is turned off and unplugged from the main electrical outlet before cleaning.

CAUTION: Do not use any form of solvents on the LCD screen or enclosure.

1. Use a soft, clean & dry cloth to gently wipe off the dust on the LCD screen.
2. Use a clean cloth dampened with water to wipe off the dirt.
3. Do not exert excessive force when cleaning the LCD screen.

CLEANING THE ENCLOSURE:

1. Use a soft, clean & dry cloth to gently wipe off the dust on the enclosure.
2. Use a clean cloth dampened with water to wipe off the dirt.
3. Do not exert excessive force when cleaning the enclosure.

Appendix B – Troubleshooting

If the unit fails to operate normally, try solving the problems using the procedures below. If the problem persists, switch off the unit and ask the dealer or technical services for assistance. Do not attempt to repair or open the defective unit as high voltage is present inside the unit.

1. No Picture
 - a. Check that the power cord is plugged into the main socket and the power is turned on at the front of the unit.
 - b. Check the contrast and brightness settings.

- c. Check the antenna connection to see if it is properly connected to the unit's input terminal (TV ANT) located on the back of the unit.
 - d. Be sure you have selected the correct source mode (TV or CABLE).
- 2. DVD Player Not Working Properly
 - a. Ensure disc is correctly inserted into the unit.
 - b. Inspect the disc is not damaged (no scratches on the recorded side of the disc) and is of correct format to play in the unit.
 - c. Please wait as some disc requires longer time to read-in prior to playing.
 - d. Eject and re-insert disc.
- 3. Snow with picture in TV/CABLE mode.
 - a. Check to see if the antenna is correctly connected.
 - b. Check to see if the picture settings are correct.
- 4. Picture flickers
 - a. Check that the power coming from the main socket is sufficient.
 - b. Check that unit is not placed too near speakers or magnetic objects.
 - c. Check to see that the unit settings are correct.
- 5. Color patch on LCD screen(Unevenness)
Ensure connections are correct.
- 6. Horizontal dots on LCD screen
Ensure connections are correct.
- 7. No sound
 - a. Ensure that the mute function is off.
 - b. Volume set too low, increase the volume setting.
- 8. Remote control not working.
 - a. Check to verify that the battery is installed correctly (+ side of battery must be facing the bottom of the remote case), replace if necessary (CR2025).
 - b. Make sure that the remote control is pointed towards the remote sensor located at the front right of the enclosure.
- 9. FM transmitter not working.
 - a. Check to ensure that it is turned ON in the Menu.
 - b. Turn it OFF in the menu and disconnect power for at least 1-hour. Then reconnect power and turn it ON in the menu.
