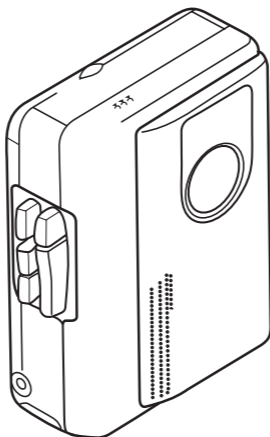

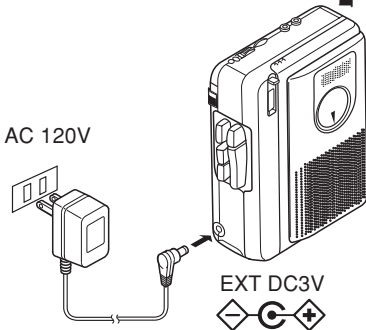

AC adaptor

Connect the AC adaptor (Part No. 645 016 1018) to the EXT DC 3V ac (Fig. 2). (The battery is a 3V alkaline battery.)

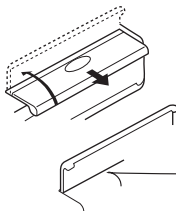

CONNECTIONS

External microphone (M-1110C only)

Connect the external microphone (M-1110C) to the MIC jack on the rear of the camera. (The external microphone is not included.)

Earphone

Connect the earphone (M-1110C) to the EAR jack on the rear of the camera. (The earphone is not included.)

RECORDING (Fig. 5)

NOTE: Do not use the C-120 camera case.

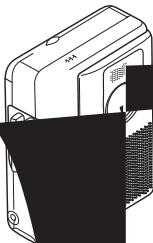
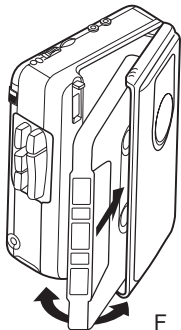

1. Load a cassette tape.
2. Press the **REC** button. The cassette will enter recording mode. (M-1110C only)
3. Set the **VAS** switch to **ON** or **OFF**. (M-1110C only)
4. Press the **REC** button. (The **PLAY** button will be activated.)

VAS ON: Voice activated recording (M-1110C only)

Fast forwarding or rewinding

Press the FFWD/CUE or REW/REV button. Press the STOP button to stop the tape. Press the FFWD/CUE or REW/REV button again to start.

Temporarily stopping operation (all modes)

Press the PAUSE button. Press the FFWD/CUE or REW/REV button to resume.

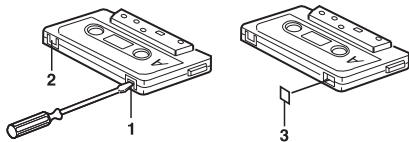
Quick reviewing and recording

When recording, press the REW/REV button (the REC button is released) to stop recording. Release the REW/REV button to resume recording. Press the REC button to resume recording.

Safeguards against accidental erasure (Fig. 7)

To erase side A, remove the cap (1). To erase side B, remove the cap (2). To erase both sides, remove the caps (3).

NOTE: The REC button can be depressed while the caps are removed.

PLAYBACK (Fig. 8)

1. Load cassette and press **PLAY** button.
2. Press **PLAY** button again to advance to the next track.
3. Press **STOP** button to stop playback.

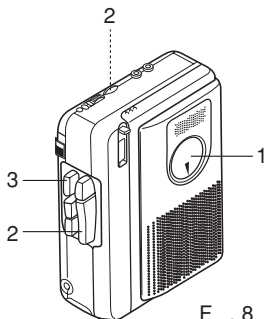

Cue and reviewing

When playback is stopped, press **FFWD/CUE** or **REW/REV** button. Release button to resume playback. Press **STOP** button to stop playback.

MAINTENANCE

To clean the cassette deck, use a soft brush (1) to clean the tape heads (2, 3), the tape guides (4, 5), and the tape compartment (6) as shown in Fig. 9.

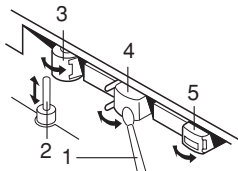
