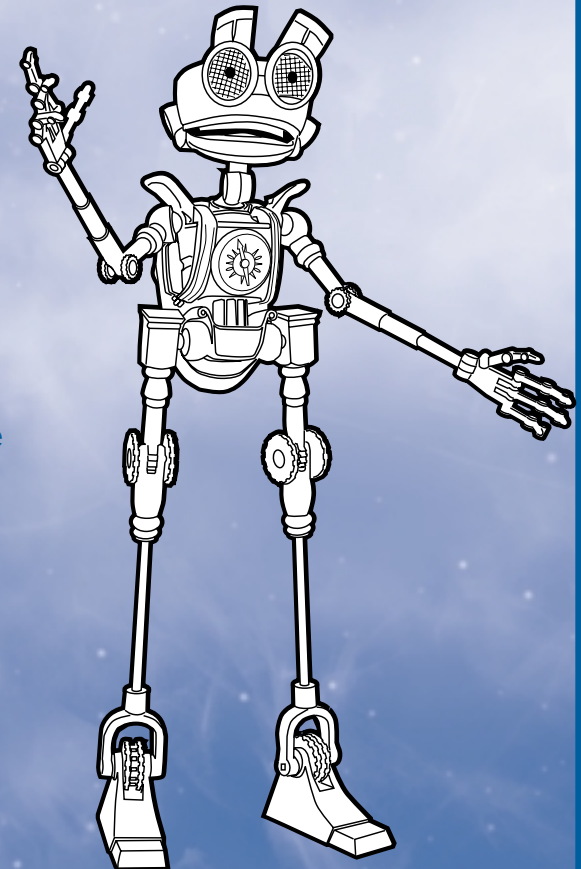

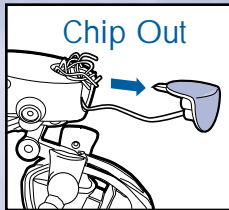

When memory chip is removed, figure says "lost" phrases.

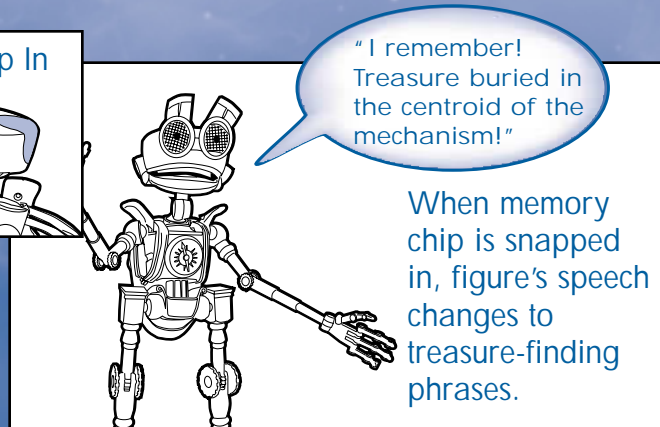
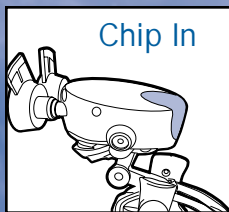
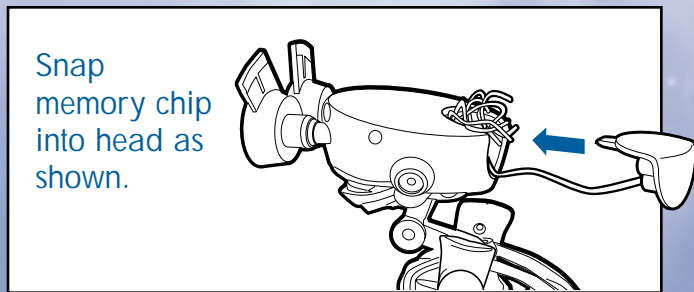
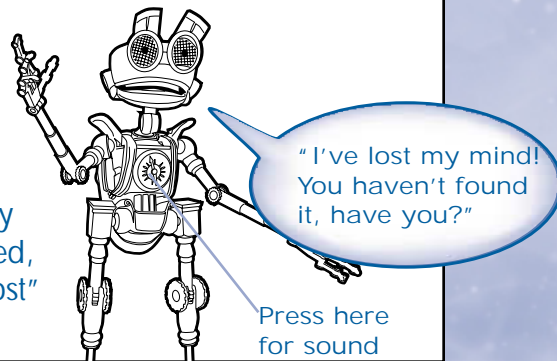
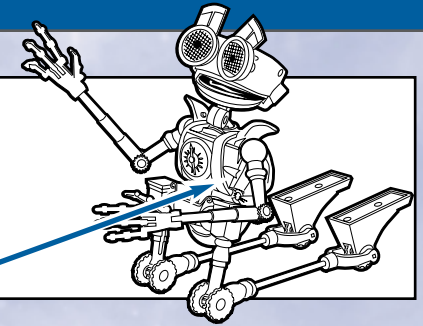


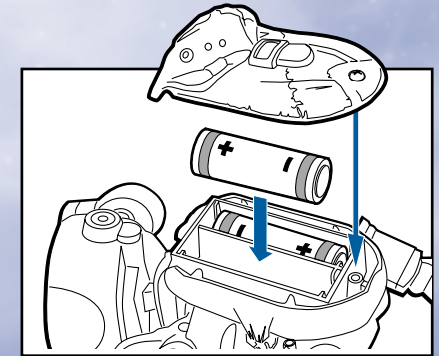
Figure folds down into rolling vehicle mode as shown.

To Replace Batteries

Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove screw in battery compartment door. Remove door. Insert 2 fresh "AA"/LR6 batteries into compartment. Replace door and fasten screw tightly.

1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturer's instructions;
